JOINT PRESS COMMUNIQUE

From 29 March to 2 April 1965 technical conversations were held in Brussels between the delegation of the Peoples' Republic of Poland to the GATT Trade Negotiations Committee, led by M. Bohdan Laczkowski, economic adviser to the Minister of External Trade, and a delegation from the EEC Commission led by M. Wolfgang Ernst, Director in the Directorate-General for External Relations.

The two delegations had already met in November 1964 to examine the problem of imports of Polish eggs into the Community.

In the March-April meetings, the delegations broadened the scope of their conversations to cover the general development of trade in farm produce. The Commission's representatives also elucidated various agricultural regulations and explained the present situation of the market, notably with regard to malt, pigmeat, cattle, beef and veal, geese, and onions, and the Polish delegation answered queries concerning Community exports of farm produce to Poland.

These talks, which will be resumed at a later date, took place in a constructive atmosphere.
