amending Regulation (EEC) No 1716/80 Laying down for 1980 certain measures for the conservation and management of fishery resources applicable to vessels flying the flag of Sweden

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

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### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Following a scientific recommendation from the ICES to increase the TAC for herring in the Skagerrak and Kattegat, consultations took place between the Community, Norway and Sweden, and between the Community and Sweden.

During these consultations, the delegations undertook to recommend to their authorities that the TAC in the Skagerrak and Kattegat should be increased and that their respective catch quotas for this stock should also be increased.

The objective of the proposed regulation is to modify the herring quota allocated to Swedish vessels, which can be caught in the Community zone in conformity with what was agreed during these consultations.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (1),

Whereas on 27 June 1980 the Council adopted Regulation (EEC) No 1716/80 (2);

Whereas the Community and the Kingdom of Sweden have concluded a Framework Agreement on fisheries;

Whereas Article 2 of the Framework Agreement provides that allotments may be adjusted in the event of unforeseen circumstances; whereas in accordance with that provision, the parties concerned have held fresh consultations on the revision of the total allowable catch (TAC) for herring in Skagerrak and Kattegat and the allocation of this TAC between the parties;

Whereas the delegations agreed to recommend to their authorities the adjustment of the shares of the TAC as laid down in the abovementioned Regulation (EEC) No 1716/80;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

## Article, 1.

Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1716/80 is hereby replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply until 31 December 1980.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
