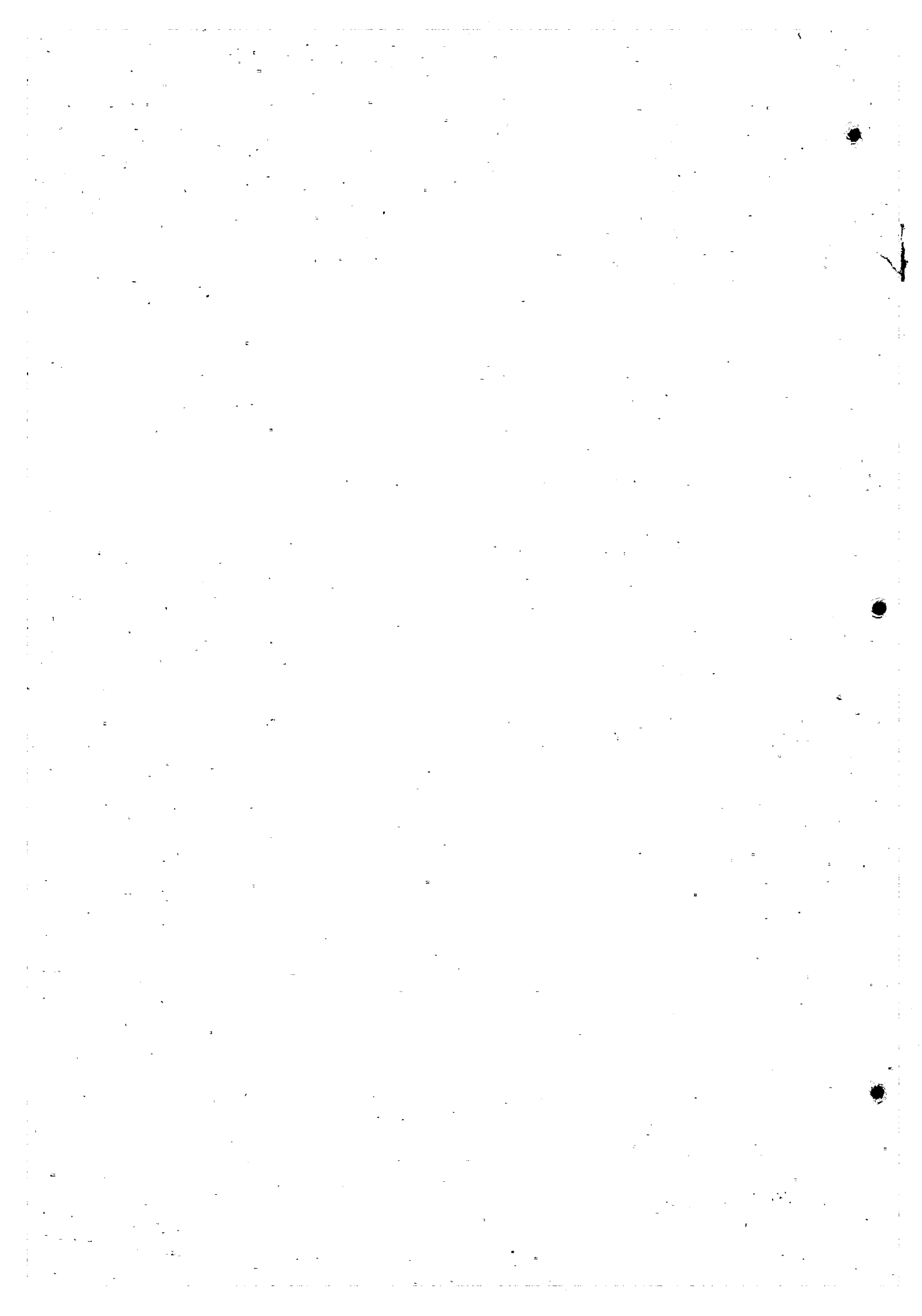

LAYING DOWN GENERAL RULES FOR THE GRANT
OF ADDITIONAL AID FOR CASTOR SEEDS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) N° 179 introducing additional aid for castor seeds laid down that the aid is to be granted for seeds which qualify for the normal aid on condition that the aid is paid to the producers.

X This proposal on the grant and supervision of the additional aid accordingly only concerns respect of the above condition.

It is laid down that the producer Member States are to ensure that this condition is respected and that the processing Member States are to pay the additional aid for all seeds for which it is found that the condition has been respected.

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

laying down general rules for the grant of additional aid for castor seeds

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) N° 179 of 1979

introducing additional aid for castor seeds for the 1979/80, 1980/81 and

1981/82 marketing years (1), and in particular Article 3(1) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, in accordance with Article 3(1) of Regulation (EEC) N° 179,

general rules should be adopted for the grant of the additional aid, together with detailed provisions for checking entitlement to the said aid;

Whereas, in order that the aid system may function properly, it should be specified that the aid is to be paid by the Member State on whose territory the seeds are processed and is to be granted in respect of seeds qualifying for the aid provided for in Article 2 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2874/77 (2), on condition that the sale price given in the contracts made with producers is not lower than the minimum price given in the said Article 2, plus the additional aid; whereas checks can be restricted to verifying that this condition has been respected,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The additional aid provided for in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 179 shall be granted on the conditions laid down in the following Articles.

Article 2

1. The additional aid shall be paid by the Member State on whose territory the seeds are processed.
2. The aid shall be granted for the quantity of castor seeds in respect of which the aid referred to in Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) N° 2874/77 is granted, on condition that the sale price given in the contracts made with producers is not lower than the minimum price referred to in the said Article 2, plus the amount of the additional aid.

Article 3

1. The producer Member States shall verify that contracts comply with the conditions required for granting the additional aid.
2. In cases where Article 6(2) of Regulation (EEC) N° 1853/78 applies, the document referred to in that Article shall state whether the seeds in question qualify for the additional aid.

Article 4

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
