

Proposal for a
COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

amending the Common Customs Tariff in respect of wines

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

COM(79) 368 final.



EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Council Regulation (EEC) N° 652/79 provides that the ECU shall be applied in the common agricultural policy. The customs duties for wines falling within subheading 22.05 C of the Common Customs Tariff are elements of the common price level for imported wines and should therefore be expressed in ECU, too. The conversion from u.a. into ECU is to be made by means of a coefficient of 1.208953. However, for practical reasons the customs duties should not be expressed with 6 decimals and this fact leads to insignificant amendments of the rates of customs duties as shown in the following table :

amending the Common Customs Tariff in respect of wines

The Council of the European Communities,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,
and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) N° 652/79 of 29 March 1979 on the impact of the European monetary system on the common agricultural policy¹ provides that amounts fixed in units of account for the purposes of the common agricultural policy shall be expressed in ECU ; whereas the customs duties for wines falling within subheading 22.05 C of the Common Customs Tariff are elements of the common price level for imported wines ; whereas the customs duties should be expressed in ECU and the exchange rate to be applied for conversion into national currency should be that applicable in the common agricultural policy ; whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 950/68 of 28 June 1968 on the Common Customs Tariff², as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 882/79³ should be amended ; whereas the conversion of the u.a. in which the customs duties are fixed into ECU should be made by means of a coefficient of 1.208953 ; whereas for practical reasons the result obtained should be rounded off,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Subheading 22.05 C of the Annex headed "Common Customs Tariff" to Regulation (EEC) No 950/68 is hereby replaced by the following :

- (a) In certain conditions, a countervailing tax is provided for in respect of certain products in addition to the customs duty.
- (b) The exchange rate to be applied in converting into national currencies the ECU in which the customs duty is expressed shall notwithstanding General Rule G3 contained in Part I, Section I be the representative rate applicable to wine, if such a rate is fixed for the purpose of the common agricultural policy.
- (c) Entry under this subheading is subject to conditions to be determined by the competent authorities.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 16 December 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
