The Citizens' Dialogue was conducted by the European Commission in cooperation with the Bertelsmann Stiftung






The future of Europe: what holds us together?

Citizens discuss cooperation in the border region, EU refugee policies and EU social policies. The set-up involved discussions in small groups followed by exchange with Martin Selmayr, Secretary-General of the European Commission as well as members of the European Parliament and mayors.

114 German, Austrian and Czech citizens, response rate to questionnaires: 93%, 106 questionnaires.



According to participating citizens, the first German-Austrian-Czech Citizens' Dialogue was a great success: over 90 per cent gave the Citizens' Dialogue the rating "very good" or "good".



"It was wonderful to be able to hear what the citizens of other countries think."









80% of citizens rated the direct discussions with politicians in the discussion sessions "good" to "very good". Martin Selmayr's participation, in particular, was praised several times


"Inviting an EU politician who even knows Passau, that was nice."
