COMMISSION COMMUNICATION TO THE COUNCIL

ON FOOD AID IN THE FORM OF BUTTEROIL

COM(79) 735 final

1. When it presented its 1979 food aid programmes for cereals, skimmed milk powder and butteroil⁽¹⁾, the Commission also proposed :
 - to provide 80 t of butteroil for the Comoros (to be set off against the balance of the reserve from the 1978 programme)⁽²⁾, and
 - to provide 900 t of butteroil for NGOs (to be set off against the balance of the reserves from the 1977 and 1978 programmes)^{(3),(4)}.
2. The aim of this Communication is to formalize the Commission's initial proposal.
3. The Commission therefore proposes to the Council :
 - (a) to adopt the three proposals herewith (Annexes I, II and III);
 - (b) to approve the distribution of 900 t of butteroil among NGOs (800 t under the 1977 programme and 100 t under the 1978 programme), broken down by recipient organization and country of destination, it being understood that the Commission would be empowered to make any necessary adjustments. Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 830/78 of 25 April 1978 laying down general rules for the supply of milk fats to certain developing countries and specialized bodies under the 1978 food-aid programme¹, and in particular Articles 3 and 8 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 831/78 of 25 April 1978 on the supply of milk fats to certain developing countries and specialized bodies under the 1978 food-aid programme² provides for the establishment of a reserve of 1440 tonnes of butteroil;

Whereas the Federal and Islamic Republic of the Comoros has requested food aid in the form of milk fats; whereas its needs warrant food aid from the Community,

Whereas in order to enable the aid to be used effectively, provision should be made to finance certain transport costs,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Of the 1440 tonnes of butteroil provided for as a reserve under Regulation (EEC) No 831/78, 80 tonnes shall be allocated to the Federal and Islamic Republic of the Comoros.

Article 2

Community financing shall cover transport costs to the port of unloading.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1769/77 of 25 July 1977 on the supply of milk fats to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1977 food-aid programme¹ provides for a reserve of 2460 tonnes of butteroil, which was increased by 300 tonnes following the cancellation of aid to the Republic of Burundi;

Whereas non-governmental organizations (NGOs) have requested food aid in the form of milk fats; whereas their needs warrant food aid from the Community;

Whereas, in order to enable the aid to be used effectively, provision should be made to finance certain transport and distribution costs,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Of the 2460 tonnes of butteroil provided for as a reserve under Regulation (EEC) No 1769/77, which were increased by 300 tonnes following the cancellation of aid to the Republic of Burundi, 800 tonnes shall be allocated to non-governmental organizations (NGOs).

Article 3
