This document shows the net changes in the case of each member State between the Commission's original proposals of last October, as corrected, and its final proposal for 1978.

The changes result variously from

- transfers of quotas as between member States
- increases in TACs in a limited number of cases
- availabilities which were not included in the previous Commission proposals

In the cases of horse mackerel and redfish, allocations to member States (and third countries) do not reach the TAC totals.
