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COMMISSION REPORT
on the operation during 1988 of the
export earnings stabilization system set up
by the third Lomé Convention

I. Introduction

1. Article 27 of the Internal Agreement on the financing and administration of Community aid stipulates:

"Each year the Commission shall draw up a comprehensive report for the Member States on the operation of the system of stabilization of export earnings and the use made by the ACP States of the funds transferred.

The report shall indicate in particular the effect of the system on the economic development of the recipient countries and on the development of external trade."

2. This report covers the activities of the ACP-EEC institutions, the administration of the system (the transfers made for the 1987 application year and the replenishment of resources) during 1988, and the utilization and economic impact of transfers.

II. Activities of the ACP-EEC institutions

3. The operation of Stabex was discussed at the following joint meetings:

- 13th session of the Council of Ministers (Mauritius, 10-11 May);
- 26th and 27th meetings of the Committee of Ambassadors (Brussels, 17 April and 21 December);
- extraordinary meeting of the Committee of Ambassadors (Brussels, 7 July);
- meeting of the Stabex subcommittee (Brussels, 13 April).

4. As regards matters already discussed by both sides in 1987 (request by some ACP States to be accorded the "all destinations" derogation as provided for in Article 150(3) of the Lomé Convention, and transfer requests for the 1980 and 1981 application years),¹ there was no change in the partners' positions during the course of 1988.

In addition to these long-standing issues, the ACP-EEC institutions received a request from Mauritania to include octopus and cuttlefish in the list of Stabex products. However, since the request was not presented until the 27th meeting of the Committee of Ambassadors, no decision on the subject was taken in 1988.

5. The ACP-EEC institutions were also called upon to take steps under Article 155(4) of the Convention in view of the shortfall in the system's resources.

6. The subject was first raised at the meeting of the ACP-EEC Council of Ministers; the Commission announced that total transfer requests exceeded resources and called upon the Council to take appropriate action.

7. The Council instructed the ACP-EEC Committee of Ambassadors to study the matter on the basis of a report prepared by the Commission.

The report was sent to the Council at the end of June; on 7 July, the Committee of Ambassadors met in Brussels. The measures adopted at this meeting (see point 14) enabled the Commission to take a decision on the transfers before the end of July in accordance with the time schedule laid down in Article 168(3) of the Convention.

III. Transfers for the 1988 application year

8. The Commission received a total of 70 transfer requests for the 1987 application year, presented by 36 ACP States.

After appraisal, 27 requests were deemed inadmissible; the remaining 43, from 29 countries, gave rise to a transfer entitlement.

9. The system's resources under Article 154 of the Lomé Convention amounted to ECU 255 415 314, made up as follows:

- annual appropriation	ECU 185 000 000
- carryover from 1986 application year	ECU 19 456 639

10. Rejected transfer requests

Seven requests were rejected for failing to reach the dependence threshold (Article 161 of the Convention).

Seventeen other requests were rejected on the grounds that there was no loss of export earnings within the meaning of Article 160 of the Convention.

A request was presented by the Comoros in connection with essential oil (ylang-ylang) exports, but the loss of earnings did not exceed the fluctuation threshold (Article 162 of the Convention).

Two transfer requests were rejected following Article 164 consultations (see point 11). Western Samoa did not confirm its request in respect of copra. The request presented by Sao Tome and Principe for cocoa was not processed since the dip in 1987 export earnings was due to higher than usual year-end stocks.

11. Results of consultations (Article 164 of the Convention)

The total for the 44 transfer bases finally amounted to ECU 933 410 684.²

In many cases, examination of a product's export and production trends in an applicant ACP State revealed significant changes. In some instances, the Commission asked for consultations with the State concerned. As a result, it was found necessary to reduce 17 transfer bases, in one case for two separate reasons:

- Reductions applied as a result of a decline in marketed production:

After consultations, transfer bases were reduced in all by ECU 129 043 646 to ECU 803 446 878.

12. Offsetting of repayment obligation

Six ACP States (Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Kenya, Madagascar, Papua New Guinea and Senegal) have, under Article 174(2), second indent, contributed to the replenishment of the system's resources "by deduction from (...) transfer rights established before any application of Article 155".

The Commission and the ACP States concerned agreed to reduce the transfer bases by the same amount as the repayment obligations in respect of transfers under the second Lomé Convention, discounted at 9.35% (annual average as at 16 June 1988 of long-term government bond interest rates for the Community), valued at 15 July 1988. The result of this operation (discounting of repayment obligations) was that the ACP States concerned repaid all their debts, amounting to over ECU 141 million, by reducing their transfer bases by slightly more than ECU 116 million, in other words redeeming their debts at an average "discount" of 17.9%.

These repayments reduced the transfer basis total to ECU 687 199 680. In Papua New Guinea's case, the operation involved the whole of one transfer basis (palm products), and part of another (copra products).

13. Since the total amount of the transfer basis still exceeded the system's resources (see point 9), the reductions described in Article 155(2) and (3) of the Convention were applied. Although this further reduced the overall transfer basis by ECU 107 755 135 to ECU 579 444 745, the resources available were still insufficient.

14. As a result, Article 155(4) of the Convention was applied. The Commission, in its decision of 22 June 1988, authorized Mr Natali to send the ACP-EEC Council of Ministers the report on the financial situation and the probable development of the system.

On the basis of this report, and as authorized by the ACP-EEC Council of Ministers meeting in Mauritius, the ACP-EEC Committee of Ambassadors met on 7 July 1988 to assess the situation and examine possible remedies within the terms of the Convention.

The Committee of Ambassadors agreed that both parties should join in boosting Stabex resources for 1987 by another ECU 120 million, made up as follows:

- remaining balances and interest from Lomé I and Lomé II ECU 80 million
- part of the reserves available from appropriations for national and regional programming under Lomé III ECU 40 million

The Committee of Ambassadors also agreed that these enlarged resources should be distributed in proportion to the transfer bases after application of the reductions under Article 155(2) and (3). Supplementary reductions further reduced the transfer bases by 35.21%.

15. The result of the operations described in points 11-14 is shown in the following tables:

- Table 1: calculation of the transfer bases before application of Article 155.
- Table 2: application of Article 155 and calculation of transfers (actual payments).

Table 3 shows the results for the year; it lists the transfers agreed and includes amounts offset as well as actual payments. Adding these two figures together gives the total of agreed transfers - ECU 491 661 312.

As the table shows, the chief transfer recipient was Côte d'Ivoire, which attracted more than a quarter of the total. Three recipients accounted for nearly half (48%) the overall total, and five recipients for nearly two thirds (64%).

Coffee alone accounted for more than half the amount distributed while other products whose price fell significantly in comparison with previous years (cocoa, oil crops, cotton and tea) accounted for much smaller transfers. Moreover, in addition to coffee and cocoa, all these products had already attracted large transfers in the 1986 application year. Oil crop prices actually rose in 1987, but 1986 was a very bad year and they remained far short of 1985, and especially 1984, levels.

18. Although the amounts transferred represented only a proportion of the loss of earnings recorded in 1987, they nonetheless contributed significantly to the export revenues of ACP States. Thus total transfers amounted to around one third of export earnings from all products for countries such as Burundi, Vanuatu and Western Samoa and almost a quarter for Rwanda.

The additional revenue provided by Stabex is particularly significant when measured in relative terms i.e. compared to the revenue derived from the export of a given product. In several cases, transfers approached or even exceeded 1987 export earnings:

These high ratios are partly explained by the fact that export levels for some products are fairly low and fluctuate considerably from one year to another. Thus when low market prices (basically affecting oil crops and coffee) are accompanied by specific sectoral difficulties, the drop in exports may be substantial, resulting in relatively high transfers.

However, Stabex transfers can also account for a significant percentage of earnings from major export goods:

IV. Replenishment of resources

19. The Commission continued its investigation of the repayment conditions referred to in Article 43 of the second Convention for transfers under Lomé II. The investigation focused on 1981-87 transfers ("ordinary" years and distribution of the remaining Lomé II appropriation).

None of these transfers gave rise to a repayment obligation.

20. Actual repayment in 1988 of transfers under the second Lomé Convention amounted to a total of ECU 144 085 369.

The economic situation of these countries was such that replenishment was made under the more favourable provisions of Article 174(2) of the present Convention:

- by direct repayment to the system:

The only remaining transfers paid under Lomé II still covered by the replenishment arrangements and for which the replenishment conditions have been met are two transfers received by Jamaica for bananas amounting to ECU 4 295 408.

The repayment conditions for transfers in the first two years of application of the third ACP-EEC Convention which were covered by the replenishment arrangements and paid in 1986-87, were not met. The transfers were:

V. Utilization of transfers

21. Under Articles 170 and 171 of the third ACP-EEC Convention, the procedure for monitoring the utilization of transfers has been reinforced.

Before receiving any payment, the ACP States now have to provide the Commission with "substantial information" on the programmes and operations to which they undertake to allocate the transfers. For its part, the Commission has to ensure that these programmes comply with the objectives of the system. Post-payment control of the utilization of transfers has also been strengthened; henceforth, if ACP States do not present utilization reports or if these reports call for comment the Commission can, in certain cases, suspend application of decision on subsequent transfers.

22. The provisions of Articles 170-171 of the Convention require ACP States to make an additional effort in presenting allocation decisions and provide for the Commission to participate at this stage of the transfer utilization monitoring process; however, this has tended to slow down implementation of transfer decisions under the present Lomé Convention.

Right from the start (1985 application year), several payments were delayed after the Commission's decision because of lack of information on utilization programmes; the same thing occurred the following year. Out of a total of 68 transfers over these two years, payment of more than a third (25 - 9 in 1985 and 16 in 1986) was delayed, despite the scheme's traditionally quick response time.

23. There was some improvement with transfers for the 1987 application year: by the end of January 1989 all transfers except one had been made, and only 9 had been delayed more than two months after the date of the decision or the signing of the transfer agreement.

There are two reasons for this change:

(i) an increasing number of ACP States have more experience of the present Convention's requirements regarding transfer utilization. Moreover, some 1987 transfers did little more than supplement the financing of operations already the target of previous transfers;

(ii) recipient countries and the Commission have established monitoring procedures for the utilization of transferred resources which allow payment to be kept separate from actual disbursement. Thus transfers are paid into special accounts (interest-bearing where necessary) which are only debited, once a decision has been taken on the operations they are meant to finance; this often involves close collaboration with the Commission, even to the extent of countersigning debit orders for the accounts holding the transfers.

However, the speed at which funds are made available to ACP States is not always matched by the speed at which appropriate projects or programmes are identified.

24. In theory, the procedure has two advantages. Firstly, the transfers reach the recipient countries quickly, directly benefiting the balance of payments and avoiding delays from having to submit detailed utilization programmes requiring review by the Commission. Secondly, the Commission can monitor whether the use made of transfer payments is in line with system objectives, without it being necessary to request information (frequently not given) or resort to Article 171(3) of the Convention (suspension of subsequent transfers).

It goes without saying that this procedure (first applied to the 1986 transfers) does not exempt ACP States, except in very specific cases, from having to submit reports on the actual utilization of transfers. Furthermore, in the last two application years this method of managing transfers has only been applied to twelve⁶ countries, and not necessarily to all the funds transferred in each case.

25. Annex 1 provides a summary of all operations financed from Stabex transfers for the first three years of Lomé III and indicates the conditions under which the payments took place. The Commission's information comes from three different sources: transfer utilization reports, utilization commitments prior to payment, and other information such as that which the Commission or its country representatives obtain in the course of managing special accounts.

26. Although the accuracy and quality of this information can vary considerably, it does allow a preliminary assessment of the types of operation to which transfers have been allocated. Thus Annex 2 shows transfer allocation by recipient sector on an initial allocation basis or, in cases where the funds have been transferred in their entirety,⁷ their reported utilization. However, the picture is far from clear in that it is often very hard to identify the sector benefiting from an operation (e.g. rural road works); indeed, the very concept of "sector" is not necessarily appropriate (beans in Ethiopia, shea nuts, etc.). In addition, the fungible nature of budgetary resources⁸ means that the identification of financing sources for the measures described in recipient country budgets has only indicative value.

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None the less, even if the information is not as accurate as it might be, it does give a general idea of the allocation of funds transferred.

(a) Approximately three-quarters of the total was allocated to the sectors in which the cause of the transfers lay, and more than 80% to the agricultural export sector generally;

(b) agriculture (including the agri-food industries) accounted for more than 95%, the remainder being allocated to other economic activities (industry, mining) or social activities (subsidized housing, training);

(c) even when sums were not allocated to production or marketing activities in the sector directly concerned by the transfer, they still came under the broad heading of "diversification" and as such absorbed slightly more than a quarter of the transfer total.

27. The form of transfer-financed operations varied considerably. Here, a distinction should be made between operations financed with foreign currency and those financed with local currency.

In the first case, there is enough information to identify the financing of agricultural input imports (seed, fertilizers, other chemical products), agricultural machinery, raw materials for agriculture or the agri-food industries, or agricultural vehicles.

Local currency operations usually involve supporting producer prices and covering the local costs of building and maintaining raw material processing plants and rural infrastructure.

Generally speaking, however, the information available on utilization tends to overlook this distinction between foreign and local currency expenditure⁹ - the latter being counterpart funds corresponding to the foreign currency resources which have not been allocated to operations directly compatible with the system's objectives.¹⁰

28. The institutional framework within which measures are carried out is another aspect of the allocation of funds which is very variable. In some cases, the ACP State itself finances specific operations in productive sectors through its general investment (or operating) budget. In other cases, semi-public bodies such as caisses de stabilisation or Marketing Boards implement the programmes.

The projects financed may be new projects, made possible thanks to transfers, or existing projects, including projects co-financed by the Community or other donors. It is in the latter case that fungibility has become a serious problem.

VI. Transfer utilization reports

29. As mentioned above, the provisions of Article 171 of the Lomé Convention oblige ACP States to submit reports on the utilization of transferred funds within twelve months of the signing of the transfer agreements.

As at the end of January 1989, the Commission had still not received some transfer utilization reports for the 1985 and 1986 applications years. The following reports are due:

30. In addition, some transfer utilization reports relating to the second ACP-EEC Convention have still not been transmitted by the recipient States despite regular reminders from the Commission. As at the end of January 1989, a number of countries had still not sent the Commission any report whatsoever on the utilization of transfers arising from the 1982-84 application years and the allocation of the remaining Staber balance under Lomé II:

31. As regards transfer utilization reports for Lomé III, the Commission not only reminds ACP States which are late in submitting reports of their contractual obligations, but also frequently comments on the reports which are submitted and may request additional information on the operations described.

Although the Commission has so far never had to apply the procedure laid down in Article 171(3) of the Convention, payment of the balance of the transfer due after an advance was delayed in the case of Mali (1986 transfer) and, in addition, a number of ACP States were recently told that delays in presenting transfer utilization reports could result in suspended application of decisions on subsequent transfers for the 1988 application year.

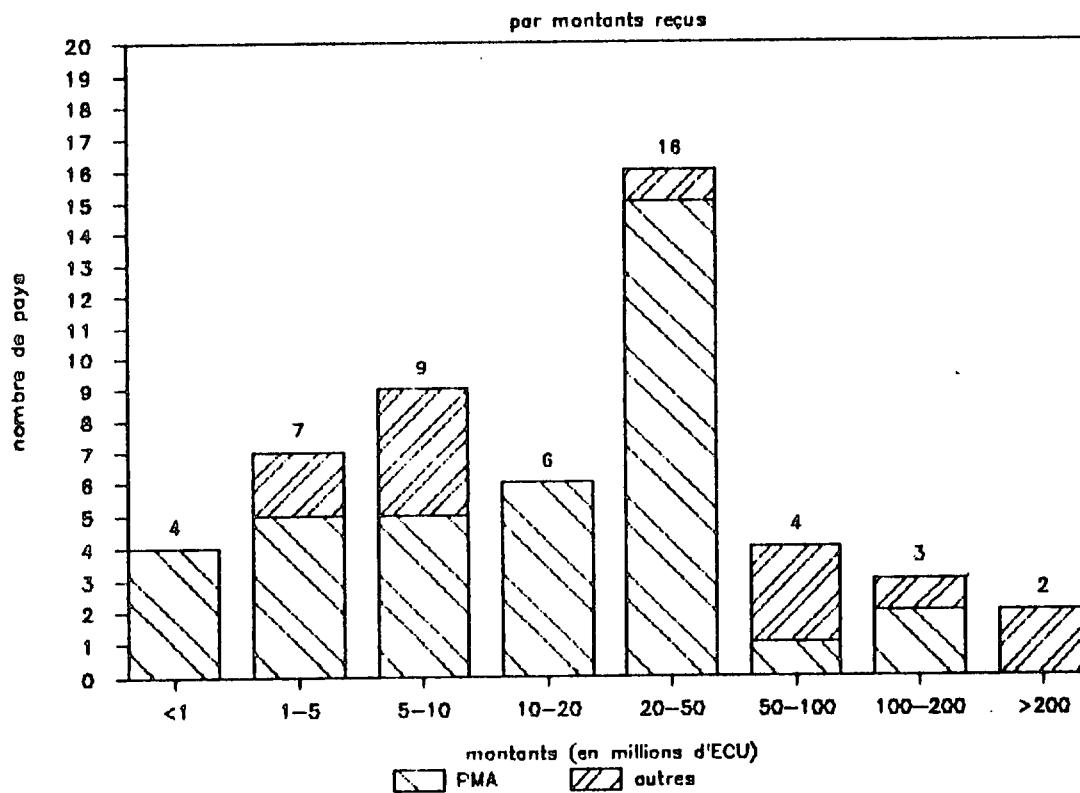

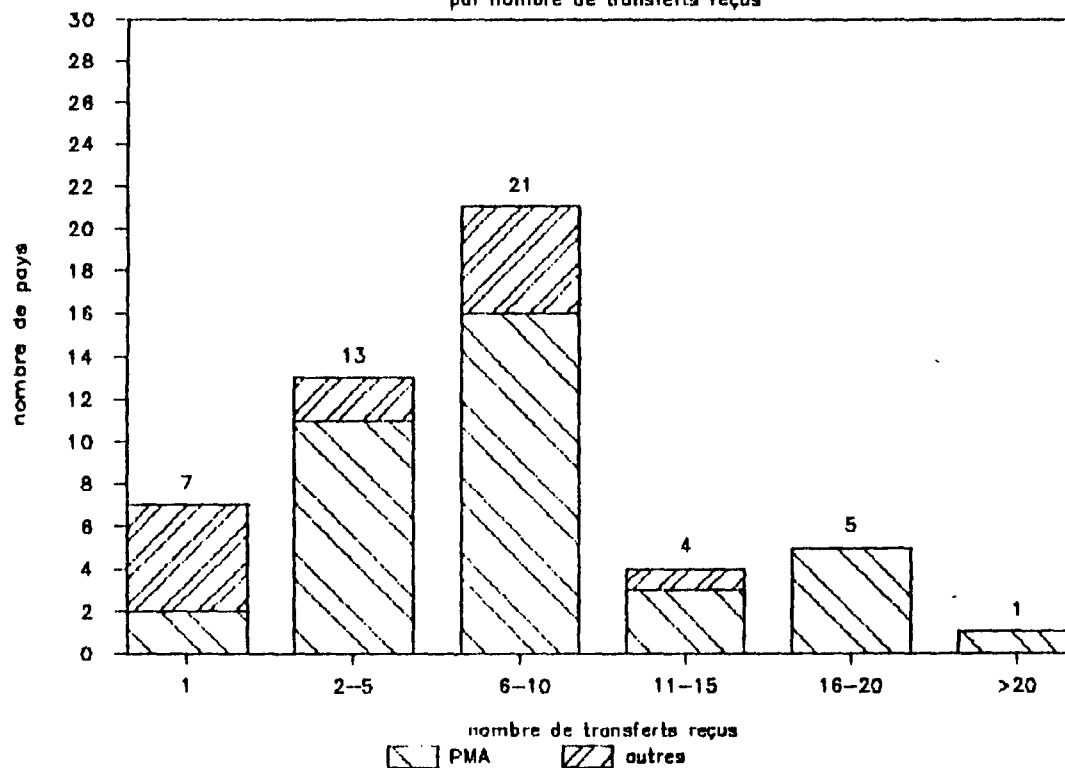

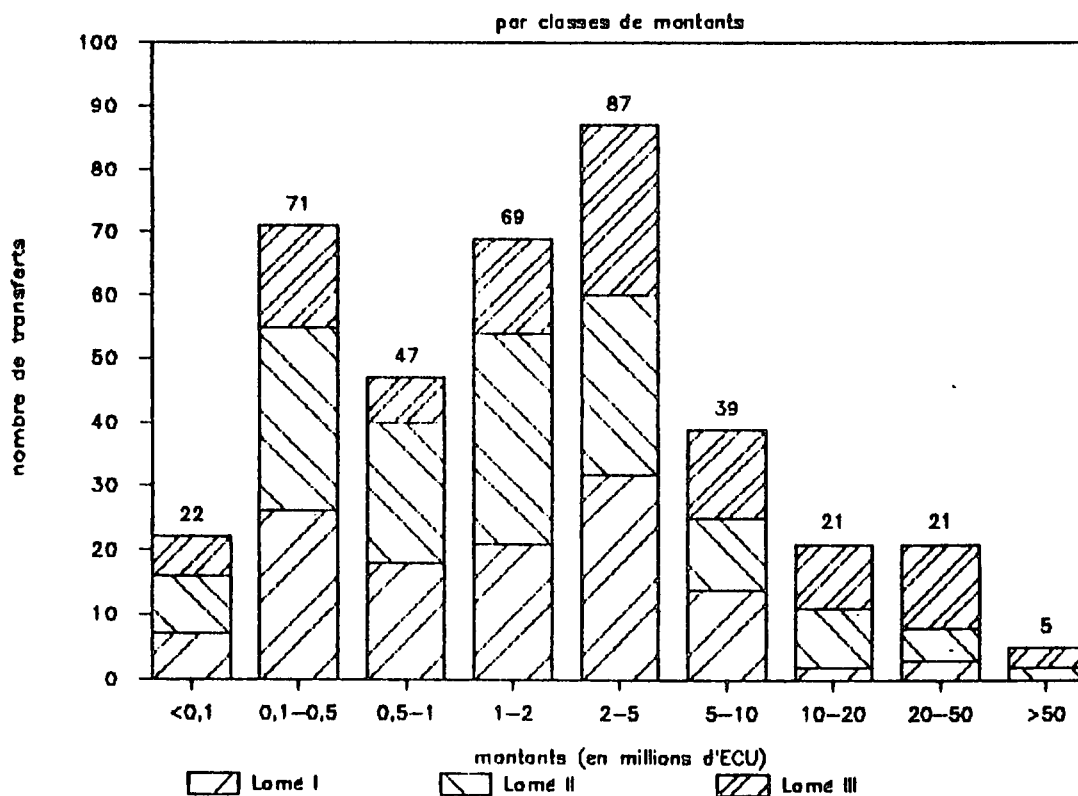
