#### Proposal for a

### COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

opening and providing for the administration of Community tariff quotas for cod and fish of the species Boreogadus saida, originating in Norway

(1990)

(presented by the Commission)

1. The Agreements in the form of exchanges of letters between the European Economic Community and Norway concerning agriculture and fisheries, approved by the Council Decision of 15 September 1986, provide in particular for the annual opening, on a date to be arranged by common accord, of Community tariff quotas for the following products originating in Norway, for which the volumes and duties applicable are given below:

- 2. The purpose of this proposal is to implement these tariff quotas for the period 1 April to 31 December 1990, taking into account the entry into force of the Combined Nomenclature, which replaces the nomenclature of the Common Customs Tariff.
- 3. In order to respect the ruling of the Court of Justice of 27 september 1988 in case 51/87 the Commission proposes not to allocate the tariff quota volumes among the Member States but to allow the latter to draw against the said volumes quantities corresponding to their immediate needs, as is the usual practice in similar cases. In addition, this procedure is more in keeping with the Community nature of these tariff quotas.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof.

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Spain and Portugal,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas an Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Kingdom of Norway was concluded on 14 May 1973; whereas, consequent on the accession of the Kingdom of Spain and the Portuguese Republic to the Community, an Agreement in the form of Exchanges of Letters was concluded and approved by Decision 86/557/EEC (1);

Whereas, the latter Agreement provides for the opening, on a date to be fixed by common accord, of Community tariff quotas at reduced or zero duty for cod and fish of the species Boreogadus saida originating in Norway; whereas the tariff quotas in question should therefore be opened for the period agreed from 1 April to 31 December 1990;

Whereas equal and continuous access to the said quotas should be ensured for all Community importers and the rates laid down for the quotas should be applied consistently to all imports of the products in question into all the Member States until the quotas are exhausted;

Whereas, the necessary measures should be taken to ensure that these tariff quotas are administred effeciently and on a Community basis, so that Member States have the option of drawing the necessary quantities corresponding to actual imports recorded, from the quota volumes; whereas, this method of administration calls for close cooperation between the Member States and the Commission;

Whereas, since the Kingdom of Belgium, the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg are united within and jointly represented by the Benelux Economic Union, any operation concerning the administration of the quotas may by carried out by any one of its members,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION

#### Article !

1. From ! April to 31 December 1990, the customs duties applicable to imports of the following products originating in Norway shall be suspended at the levels indicated and within the limits of Community tariff quotas as shown below:

Within the limits of the above tariff quotas the Kingdom of Spain and the Portuguese Republic shall apply duties of 2,6 and 0 % respectively.

- 2. Where the Community has fixed a reference price for the products or categories of products concerned, imports of those products shall benefit from the quotas referred to in paragraph 1 only if the free-a-frontier price determined by the Member States in accordance with Article 21 of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1495/89(2), is at least equal to the reference price.
- 3. The Protocol concerning the definition of the concept of 'originating products' and methods of administrative cooperation annexed to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Kingdom of Norway shall apply.

#### Article 2

The tariff quota referred to in Article 1 shall be managed by the Commission, which may take all appropriate administrative measures in order to ensure effective administration thereof.

#### Article 3

If an importer presents in a Member State a declaration of entry into free circulation, including a request for benefit under the preferential system for a product covered by this Regulation and if this T is accepted by the customs authorities, the Member States concerned shall inform the Commission and draw an amount corresponding to its requirements from the quota volume.

The drawing requests, with indication of the date of acceptance of the said declarations, must be transmitted to the Commission without delay.

The drawings shall be granted by the Commission by reference to the date of acceptance of the declarations of entry into free circulation by the customs authorities of

the Member States concerned to the extent that the available balance so permits.

If a Member State does not use the quantities drawn, it shall return them as soon as possible to the corresponding quota amount.

If the quantities requested are greater than the available balance of the quota amount, allocation shall be made on a pro rata basis with respect to the requests. Member States shall be informed thereof by the Commission.

#### Article 4

Each Member State shall ensure importers of the products concerned Y access to the quotas for such time as the residual balance of the quota volumes so permits.

#### Article 5

The Member States and the Commission shall cooperate closely to ensure that this Regulation is complied with.

#### Article 6

This Regulation shall enter into forcer on 1 April 1990.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
