EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. *With Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3074/89 of 13.10.1989 provisional anti-dumping duties on imports of welded tubes, of iron or non alloy steel, originating in Yugoslavia and Romania were imposed.*
2. *In the meantime the cooperative Yugoslavian and Romanian exporters demanded oral hearings to make their points of view known to the Commission services and offered undertakings.*
3. *The Commission services consider that an extension of the provisional duties is necessary to enable them to make a definitive assessment of the facts.*
4. *The exporters concerned and the members of the Anti-dumping Committee have been informed and did not object.*
5. *Referring to Article 11 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 the Commission proposes to extend the validity of the provisional anti-dumping duties on imports of welded tubes, of iron or non alloy steel, originating in Yugoslavia and Romania, for a period not exceeding two months.*

*THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,*

*Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,*

*Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidized imports from countries not members of the European Economic Community<sup>1)</sup>, and in particular Article 11 thereof,*

*Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,*

*Whereas by Regulation (EEC) No 3074/89<sup>2)</sup>, the Commission imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of welded tubes, of iron or non alloy steel, originating in Yugoslavia and Romania;*

*Whereas the examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the Commission has informed the Yugoslavian and Romanian exporters concerned of its intention to propose an extension of the period of validity of the provisional duty for a further period not exceeding two months; exporters cooperating in this proceeding did not object;*

*HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:*

**Article 1**

*The provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of welded tubes, of iron or non alloy steel, originating in Yugoslavia and Romania, imposed by Regulation (EEC) No 3074/89 is hereby extended for a period not exceeding two months.*

*Without prejudice to Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 and to any other decision taken by the Council, it shall apply until the entry into force of an act of the Council adopting definitive measures.*

**Article 2**

*This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.*

*This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.*
