Explanatory memorandum

- Commission Regulation (EC) No 2286/94 imposed a provisional antidumping duty on imports of tungsten products originating in the People's Republic of China.
- 2. Since the examination of the facts in this case has not yet been completed, the Commission informed the exporters concerned of its intention to propose an extension of the validity of the provisional duty. The exporters raised no objections to this proposal.
- 3. Accordingly, pursuant to Article 11 (5) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88, the Commission hereby submits a proposal for a Council Regulation extending the validity of the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of tungsten products originating in the People's Republic of China, for a further period of two months.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidized imports from countries not members of the European Economic Community⁽¹⁾ as last amended by Regulation (EC) No. $522/94^{(2)}$, and in particular Article 11 (5) thereof,

Having regard to the Commission proposal,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EC) No 2286/94 of 21 September 1994⁽³⁾ imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of tungsten ores and concentrates, tungstic oxide, tungstic acid, tungsten carbide and fused tungsten carbide originating in the People's Republic of China;

Whereas examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the Commission has informed the exporters known to be concerned of its intention to propose an extension of the validity of the provisional duty for an additional period of two months;

Whereas the exporters have raised no objections,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of tungsten ores and concentrates, tungstic oxide, tungstic acid, tungsten carbide and fused tungsten carbide originating in the People's Republic of China imposed by Regulation (EC) No 2286/94 is hereby extended for a period of two months until 24 March 1995. It shall cease to apply if, before that date, the Council adopts definitive measures or the proceeding is terminated under Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
