

Proposal for a

COUNCIL REGULATION (EC)

opening and administering certain Community tariff quotas in 1995
for certain agricultural products and for beer

(presented by the Commission)



Explanatory Memorandum

1. Pursuant to Articles 76, 102 and 128 of the Act of Accession, Austria, Finland and Sweden must apply, with effect from 1 January 1995, the provisions of the preferential agreements concluded by the Community with certain third countries (Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania), it being understood that all the amendments required as a result of the enlargement will be the subject of additional protocols to be negotiated with the countries in question.

However, the above Articles stipulate that if the protocols are not concluded by 1 January 1995 the Community must take the necessary steps to regulate the situation on accession.

2. In view of the fact that because of technical difficulties and tight deadlines the protocols will not now enter into force on 1 January 1995, it is vital to apply autonomous transitional measures so as to take account of the agricultural trade arrangements which existed between the new Member States and the third countries in question.

This proposal is aimed at taking into account conventional preferential tariff quotas. At the earliest possible opportunity the Commission will put forward a proposal which is intended also to cover traditional trade flows not covered by those quotas.

However, such measures, which should not prejudice the result of the exploratory discussions being held with a view to the conclusion of the protocols, will only be adopted on the express condition that the third countries concerned take reciprocal autonomous measures too. As far as the measures themselves are concerned, they will be restricted to a duration of one year and will in principle take the form of new Community tariff quotas where no equivalent concession exists in the preferential agreements with the Community of 12 or, otherwise, will be limited to a simple increase in existing tariff quotas.

Quotas granted by the new Member States which are for less than 100 tonnes or 100 head will be ignored.

Where the Community is concerned, the list of the measures will be contained in Annex I (products managed on the basis of import licences) and Annex II (products managed via the Customs Code Committee).

3. The Community is also obliged to open negotiations under Article XXIV(6) of the GATT to take account of the adoption by the new Member States of the Common Customs Tariff. Here, too, it will be impossible to complete them by 1 January 1995 so autonomous transitory measures should be provided for in anticipation of the result of the negotiations under Article XXIV(6). This, too, will involve introducing autonomous Community tariff quotas corresponding to the imports of the new Member States under conventional tariff quotas. Since the results of the Uruguay Round negotiations will not apply to the products concerned until 1 July 1995 those quotas should only be opened for 6 months without prejudice to the results of the negotiations opened under Article XXIV(6) of the GATT.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden,


Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, under the Europe Agreements, the interim agreements and the free trade agreements between the European Economic Community of the one part, and Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania of the other part (hereinafter called "third countries"), concessions regarding certain agricultural products have been granted to most of those countries;

Whereas, as a result of the accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden, those concessions should be adjusted to take into account the arrangements for trade in agricultural products which existed between Austria, Finland and Sweden of the one part, and Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania of the other part;

Whereas to that end exploratory talks are in progress with those third countries with a view to the conclusion of additional protocols to the above-mentioned agreements;

Whereas, however, because of excessively tight deadlines, the additional protocols cannot enter into force on 1 January 1995;



Whereas in these circumstances and pursuant to Articles 76, 102 and 128 of the Act of Accession, the Commission must adopt the measures required to remedy the situation; whereas, given the very short time remaining before the accession of the new Member States, those measures must take the form of autonomous Community tariff quotas covering the conventional preferential tariff quotas applied by Austria, Finland and Sweden;

Whereas the new Member States must apply the import arrangements applicable in the Community with effect from 1 January 1995;

Whereas Austria has undertaken under the GATT to open tariff quotas for certain products; whereas those undertakings must be renegotiated as a result of the accession of Austria to the Community;

Whereas, however, maintenance of the tariff quotas resulting from the undertakings should be guaranteed temporarily; whereas, therefore, it is necessary to open autonomous Community tariff quotas taking account of the undertakings, without prejudice to the results of negotiations under the GATT following the accession of the new Member States,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Without prejudice to the import arrangements in the Community applicable to certain agricultural products pursuant to agreements concluded between the Community and Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania, existing Community tariff quotas shall be increased or, as necessary, new Community tariff quotas shall be opened autonomously in accordance with Annexes I and II to this Regulation.



Article 2

Autonomous Community tariff quotas shall be opened in accordance with Annex III to this Regulation.

Article 3

Detailed rules of application for the products referred to in Annex I shall be adopted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 27 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68¹ or in the corresponding Articles of the other Regulations on the common organisation of the markets concerned.

Article 4

Articles 2 to 7 of Regulation (EEC) No 1798/94² shall apply to the tariff quotas referred to in Annex II.


Article 5

1. For the products referred to in Annex III other than beer, the detailed rules, including any extension, and in particular:
 - (a) provisions guaranteeing the nature, provenance and origin of the product,
 - (b) provisions relating to recognition of the documents attesting to the guarantees referred to in (a), and
 - (c) conditions for the issuance and period of validity of import licences,

shall be adopted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 27 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 or in the corresponding Articles of the other Regulations on the common organisation of the markets concerned.

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2. With regard to beer, the detailed rules shall be the same as those adopted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 16 of Regulation (EEC) No 3448/93 in application of the tariff concessions laid down in Protocol 3 to the interim agreement on trade and accompanying measures between the European Economic Community and the European Coal and Steel Community, of the one part, and the Czech Republic, of the other part.

Article 6

This Regulation shall enter into force on the date of entry into force of the Act of Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.






