EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this Regulation is to fix the guide prices for 1998 for the products in Annex I(A), (D) and (E) to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 on the common organisation of the market in fishery and aquaculture products. Article 9 of that Regulation states that a guide price for each of these products is to be fixed for each fishing year on the basis of the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output and a product with given commercial characteristics on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for which the price is fixed. Account is also taken of the production and demand prospects and other criteria relating to the stabilisation of market prices, support for producers' incomes and consumers' interests.

As in previous years, the procedure for fixing the prices for 1998 has been based on a comparison between the average of prices recorded between 1995 and the first six months of 1997 and that for the period between 1994 and 1996, which was used as a basis for fixing the guide prices for 1997.

The reduction in white fish prices recorded in the most recent fishing year has eased slightly, giving rise to a more favourable situation between 1995 and 1997 than between 1994 and 1996 with more or less stable prices, haddock being the notable exception (-4%). Prices for white fish have been higher in the first half of 1997 than they were in the first half of 1996.

In view of the long-term trend in prices, the Commission proposes an increase of 1-3% in the prices for certain species of white fish, with the exception of dogfish (Scyliorhinus spp), saithe, whiting, hake, megrim, Ray's bream and whole monkfish for which it recommends no change; for dogfish (Squalus acanthias), cod and haddock the Commission proposes a cut of 1-2%.

With regard to pelagic species, prices between 1995 and 1997 (as compared with the period 1994-96) varied between -6% and +44%, with a less favourable trend for the first half of 1997 than for the first half of 1996: from -39% to +28%. The Commission proposes price changes from -3% to +3% for pelagic species and for albacore.

As regards the other species (shrimps, crabs, Norway lobster and cuttlefish), the Commission proposes no change for cooked deep-water prawns, +1% for Norway lobster, -1% for crabs, cuttlefish and fresh deep-water prawns and -2% for common shrimps.

It is proposed therefore:

to lower the guide price for dogfish (Squalus acanthias) by 1%, for cod by 1%, for haddock by 2%, for Spanish mackerel by 3%, for anchovy by 1%, for common shrimps by 2%, for edible crab by 1%, for albacore by 2%, for cuttlefish by 1% and for fresh deep-water prawns by 1%;

- to maintain in 1998 the guide prices applicable in 1997 for herring, dogfish (Scyliorhinus spp.), saithe, whiting, hake, megrim, Ray's bream, whole monkfish, and cooked deep-water prawn;
- to raise the guide price for sardine, redfish, ling, headed monkfish and Norway lobster by 1%, for plaice and flounder by 2% and for mackerel, dab and sole by 3%.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 of 17 December 1992 on the common organization of the market in fishery and aquaculture products ¹, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3318/94 ², and in particular Article 9 (3) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 9 (1) and (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 provides that a guide price shall be fixed for each of the products listed in Annex I (A), (D) and (E) of the Regulation at a level which will help to stabilize market prices and avoid the formation of surpluses in the Community ; whereas that level must also help support producers' income and at the same time take account of consumers' interest ;

Whereas the guide price shall be based on the average of prices as defined in Article 9 (2) of that Regulation and on an assessment of production and demand prospects ;

Whereas the application of these criteria involves for the 1998 fishing year, an increase for certain products and the stabilization or decrease of prices for others compared with prices applicable during the current fishing year;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The guide prices for the fishing year from 1 January to 31 December 1998 for the products listed in Annex I (A), (D) and (E) to Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 and the commercial categories to which they relate are fixed in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 on the common organisation of the market in fishery products provides that, for each of the products listed in Annex II, a guide price is to be fixed for a product with given commercial characteristics on the basis of the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for which the price is fixed.

Examination of the market price trends and the level of the guide prices for frozen products suggests that the guide prices applicable in 1998 to Illex and Loligo squid, cuttlefish, hake fillets and shrimps (other Penaeidae) should be reduced.

In these circumstances the Commission proposes to adjust the Community guide prices in line with market trends and thus reduce the price for Illex squid by 2%, for Loligo squid by 3%, for cuttlefish by 1%, for hake fillets by 2% and for shrimps (other Penaeidae) by 2% for the 1998 fishing year.

On the other hand, since prices for other species have risen, guide prices for octopus, Greenland halibut and sea bream should be increased by 4%, 1% and 2% respectively.

The Commission proposes to maintain the prices for whole hake and shrimps (Parapenaeus longirostris).

Whereas Article 9 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 provides that a guide price shall be fixed annually for each of the products or groups of products listed in Annex II to that Regulation ;

Whereas, according to the data available at present concerning prices for the products in question and the criteria laid down in Article 9 (2), of that Regulation, these prices should be increased, maintained or decreased according to the species for the 1998 fishing year,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The guide prices for the fishing year 1 January to 31 December 1998 for the products listed in Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 and the commercial categories to which they relate are fixed in the Annex hereto.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) No 3759/92 on the common organisation of the market in fishery products provides that, for tuna intended for the canning industry, a Community producer price is to be fixed for a product with given commercial characteristics on the basis of the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for which the price is fixed.

The average Community producer price has shown a recovery over the last three years and prices rose sharply during the first six months of 1997.

However, the Community producer price fixed for 1997 (1204 E/T) remains above the average price for the three previous fishing years (1162 E/T), and competitiveness in the canning sector means that prudence should be exercised when fixing prices. Under these circumstances the Commission proposes to increase Community producer prices for tuna by 1% for the 1998 fishing year.

Whereas, on the basis of the criteria laid down in the first and second indents of Article 9(2) and in Article 17(1) of the abovementioned Regulation, the price for the 1998 fishing year should be increased,
