COMMISSION DECISION CONCERNING COAL AND COKE
FOR THE IRON AND STEEL INDUSTRY OF THE COMMUNITY

Justification

The Commission requested the European Parliament to deliver an opinion on the draft decision concerning coal and coke for the iron and steel industry of the Community (document COM(78) 516 final).

During its session of April 1979, the Parliament expressed its wish to be consulted in an emergency foreseen in paragraph 1 of article 11.

The Commission has decided to amend its text accordingly (see appendix).

COMMISSION DECISION CONCERNING COAL AND
COKE FOR THE IRON AND STEEL INDUSTRY OF THE
COMMUNITY

Article 11

1. In an emergency, the Commission may, by decisions taken after consultation with the Consultative Committee and after the unanimous consent of the Council has been given, amend:
- the rate of the sales aids,
 - the ceiling to intra-Community trade,
 - the rules governing the financing of the special fund,
 - the scale referred to in Article 8, paragraph 2(c).

These amendments shall take account of the long-term trend of supply conditions and the supply pattern within the Community.

Article 11

1. In an emergency, the Commission may, by decisions taken after consultation with the Consultative Committee and the European Parliament and after the unanimous consent of the Council has been given, amend:
- the rate of the sales aids,
 - the ceiling to intra-Community trade,
 - the rules governing the financing of the special fund,
 - the scale referred to in Article 8, paragraph 2(c).

These amendments shall take account of the long-term trend of supply conditions and the supply pattern within the Community.
