Proposal for a Council Directive (EEC)

on returns to be made on the basis of regional statistics in respect of international carriage of goods by road

(submitted by the Commission to the Council)



EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

In the framework of the common transport policy, and of the regional policy, the Commission needs basic information on the transport of goods carried by the various modes of transport.

While important progress has been made in what concerns the transport of goods by railway and by inland waterways, the information available for road transport is only fragmentary, and experience has shown that worth while results can only be obtained in this sector by means of directives.

It is for this reason that the Commission in 1971, communicated to Council a draft directive on national transport of goods by road, which has not yet been adopted by Council for purelys financial motives advanced by one member State. The same reason caused the Commission to initiate the directive 69/467/ECE of Council, on the international transport of goods by road.

The application of this last directive has however, in the majority of Member States come up against the difficulties summarised in the report on this subject which the Commission has submitted to Council (1).

It emerged in this report that, in asking Nember States to collect data on all transport entering their territory, as well as transport with a destination in a third country, this directive directly entailed collecting data at frontiers.

At those Member States who comprise Benelux have abolished customs controls at their common frontiers, which makes it impossibly to apply the directive, and because in any case it would be contrary to the objectives of the Commission to maintains in force a directive which implicitly required controls for statistical purposes at frontiers, it therefore seems opportune to modify the directive 69/467/ECE, in order to reach, by the help of other methods, the ends which this directive pursues.

on returns to be made on the basis of regional statistics in respect of international carriage of goods by road

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic VCommunity and in particular Article 213 thereof:

Having regard to Directive 69/467/EEC of 8 December 1969 on returns, to be made on the basis of regional statistics, in respect of international carriage of goods by road (1), and especially Article 6 thereof;

Having regard to the proposals from the Commission;

Whereas Council Directive 69/467/EEC of 8 December 1969 stipulates in Article 6 (1) that the Commission shall, with the assistance of the Co-ordinating Committee for Transport Statistics at the Statistical Office of the European Communities, examine each year the results of surveys made by Member States in order to approximate the methods used as far as possible;

Whereas pursuant to Article 6 (2) of Council Directive 69/467/EEC, the Commission on 27 June 1974 submitted a report to the Council on the implementation of the Directive, and whereas it is clear from the report that several Member States can only supply the data required by means of additional frontier formalities; whereas these Member States should be enabled to dispense with the collection of statistical data at frontier posts as is implied in the provisions of the above Directive;

Whereas, in view of past and future measures relating to the common transport policy and other areas of policy, especially in the field of regional policy, more information is required on the scale of and trends in the carriage of goods between the different regions of the Community and between these regions and non-member States;

Whereas for the same reasons information is needed on the importance of the regions of the Community in the receipt and dispatch of the various groups of commodities;

Whereas radical amendment of Council Directive 69/467/EEC is thus required;

Whereas provision should be made for amending the Directive as may prove necessary in the light of experience, after a suitable trial period.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DIRECTIVE:

Article 1

Council Directive 69/467/EEC of 8 December 1969 is cancelled and replaced by the provisions below.

Article 2

Each member State shall collect data annually on the international carriage of goods by road to and from its national territory by means of goods-carrying vehicles registered in that State, whether used for carriage on own account or for carriage for hire or reward. Transport by agricultural and military vehicles shall, however, be excluded.

The first data to be collected shall be for the year 1977.

Article 3

- 1. The annual statistical data mentioned in Article 2 above shall show the tonnage carried and tonne-kilometres hauled, broken down as follows:
 - carriage on own account and for hire or reward;
 - by the chapters of the NST (Standard Nomenclature of Commodities for Transport Statistics) listed in Annex 1;
 - by the groups of commodities listed in Annex 2;
 - by the countries in which loading and unloading takes place, as listed in the nomenclature of countries set out in Annex 3;
 - by the distance covered.

2. For the years 1977 - 79 the member States shall in addition give a breakdown of the statistical data collected pursuant to Section 1 of this Article, according to the regions in which leading and unloading takes place, as listed in Annex 4.

Article 4

From 1 January 1980 the method adopted by the member States for collection of the data specified in Article 2 shall no longer require formalities to be completed specifically for this purpose for each exchange of goods within the Community.

Article 5

Member States which conduct sample surveys shall so construct their samples that they provide satisfactory results at the level of the overall figures for international transport and shall inform the Commission of the degree of accuracy of the results.

Article 6

- 1. a) Each year, before 1 October following the reference year, member States shall send to the Commission the data mentioned in Article 3 (1) in the form of tables conforming to the models in Annaxes 5 to 8 of this Directive.
 - b) Member States shall provide the Commission with a detailed report on the methods used, to be submitted on or before the date on which the first returns are made to the Commission.
- 2. a) For each of the years 1977, 1978 and 1979, the member States shall, before the end of the year following the reference year, supply the Commission with the data mentioned in Article 3 (2) in the form of tables conforming to the models in Annexes 9 and 10 of this Directive.
 - b) At the same time as the data mentioned in a) above, the member States shall supply the Commission with a report on their experience in conducting the survey and on the degree of accuracy of the results.

Article 7

- 1. Each year, the Statistical Office of the European Communities, with the assistance of the Co-ordinating Committee for Transport Statistics, shall examine the statistical tables and reports submitted by the member States pursuant to Article 6 (1) in order to harmonize as far as possible the methods employed.
- 2. The Statistical Office of the European Communities, with the assistance of the 'Road Transport Statistics' Working Party of the Co-ordinating Committee for Transport Statistics and in the light of the reports submitted by the member States, shall determine the means and the degree of detail appropriate for the use and publication by the Commission of the returns made by the member States pursuant to Article 6 (2).

Article 8

Before 1 June 1979, the Commission shall report to the Council on experience gained to date in conducting the studies made pursuant to Article 3 (2), and before 1 January 1982 it shall make a second report on the results obtained pursuant to Article 3 (1).

At the same time the Commission shall also propose any amendments to this Directive which may prove to be necessary on the basis of the experience and results obtained.

Article 9

Annexes 1 - 10 appended form an integral part of this Directive.

Article 70

The member States shall take the necessary measures to comply with this Directive on or before 1 January 1977.

Article 11

This Directive is addressed to the member States.
