# **COUNCIL REGULATION (EC)**

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

This proposal aims to extend the deadline for payment of compensation to the farmer in respect of 'non-food' set-aside up to 31 March.

The 'non-food' set-aside scheme requires the raw material concerned to be harvested and delivered before the compensation can be made. Given that some crops covered by the scheme are harvested later on in the calender year, various Member States have encountered difficulties in meeting the payment deadline of 31 December which is provided for in Article 10(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1765/92.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Articles 42 and 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament,

Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee,

Whereas, where raw materials for the manufacture of products not intended for direct use for human or animal consumption are produced on set-aside land, the delivery of those raw materials to the processor must be confirmed for control reasons before compensation may be paid to the applicant; whereas experience has shown that compliance with this rule makes it difficult to pay the compensation concerned by the deadline of 31 December; whereas the deadline for paying the compensation for the set-aside obligation should be postponed to 31 March in cases where the land set-aside is used for the production of raw materials for the manufacture of products not intended for direct use for human or animal consumption,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

### Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 1765/92 is hereby amended as follows:

The following sentence is added to Article 10 (1):

"However, where Article 7 (4) applies, compensation for the set-aside obligation shall be paid between 16 October and 31 March of the following year."

### Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply from the 1997/98 marketing year.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
