# **COUNCIL REGULATION (EC)**

amending Annexes II and III to Regulation (EC) No 519/94 on common rules for imports from certain third countries

(presented by the Commission)



#### **Explanatory Memorandum**

On 29 January 1997<sup>1</sup> the Commission forwarded to the Council a report on the quantitative quotas and surveillance measures, applicable to certain non-textile products originating in the P. R. of China, introduced under Council Regulation (EC) No 519/94 of 7 March 1994<sup>2</sup>, last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1897/96 of 1 October 1996<sup>3</sup>.

The attached proposal contains the practical amendments to Regulation (EC) No 519/94 stemming from the conclusions drawn by the Commission in that report:

- abolition of the quota on Glass tableware (CN code 7013) (this product being however subjected to surveillance measures);
- exclusion of "parts and accessories of toys" from the quota on Toys (CN codes 9503 41 + 9503 49 + 9503 90);
- abolition of surveillance measures on 4 products of which imports in 1995 were negligible or down on 1994 (certain food preparations, certain glass products, not alloyed zinc and car radios).

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EC) No 519/94 of 7 March 1994<sup>1</sup> on common rules for imports from certain third countries, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1897/96 of 1 October 1996<sup>2</sup>, introduced in respect of the People's Republic of China the quotas listed in Annex II to this Regulation and surveillance measures listed in Annex III thereto;

Whereas in establishing the quotas, the Council's objective was to strike a balance between an appropriate level of protection for the Community industries concerned and maintenance of an acceptable level of trade with the P. R. of China, taking into account the various interests in play;

Whereas analysis of the main economic indicators, in particular the volume and market share of Chinese imports, leads to the conclusion that the quota on glass tableware falling within HS/CN code 7013 should be abolished and that such abolition would be neither inconsistent with the above objective nor liable to disrupt the Community market;

Whereas the products in respect of which the quota is abolished by this Regulation should, however, be subject to prior Community surveillance; in order to ensure adequate monitoring of the volume and prices of the imports of the products concerned;

Whereas the quota on toys falling within HS/CN code 9503 41, 9503 49 and 9503 90 includes parts and accessories of toys; whereas in light of the experience of the Community producers the effects of this inclusion go beyond what is necessary for the appropriate protection of the Community industry concerned; whereas parts and accessories of toys should therefore be excluded from the quota;

Whereas it is no longer considered necessary to maintain surveillance measures on a range of products of which the imports in 1995 were negligible or lower than in 1994 and they should be removed from the list of products subject to surveillance measures;

Whereas the quantitative quotas and the surveillance measures introduced under Regulation (EC) No 519/94 should therefore be amended,

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Article 1

Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 519/94 shall be replaced by the Annaex which appears in Annex I to this Regulation.

#### Article 2

Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 519/94 shall be replaced by the Annex which appears in Annex II to this Regulation.

#### Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities. It shall be applicable from 1 January 1997.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
