Explanatory memorandum

The Community signed on 18 July 1994 Agreements on free trade and trade-related matters with Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania. These Agreements entered into force on 1 January 1995, after the General Affair Council of 19 December 1994 had adopted the decisions of conclusion of these Agreements.

It is therefore necessary to set up the legal basis allowing the Commission to implement the provisions of these Agreements dealing with agricultural products.

The Council is requested to adopt the following proposed Regulations.

TITLE I

Agricultural products

Article 1

Where the application of the Agreement calls for close cooperation with Estonia, the Commission may take any measure necessary to ensure such cooperation.

Article 2
