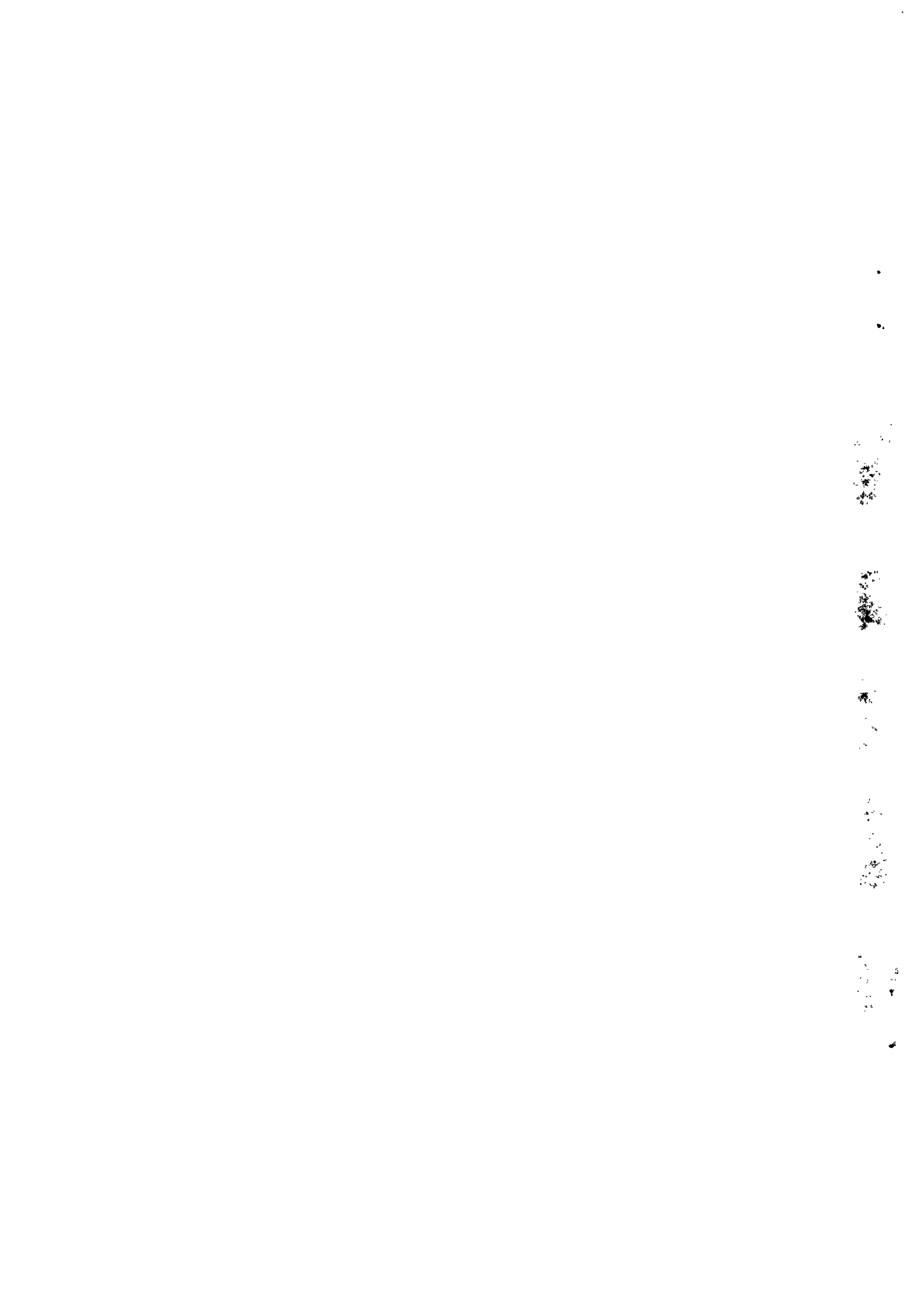

On 18 September 1985 the Committee on Budgetary Control confirmed the appointment of Mr Klaus WETTIG as rapporteur.

The committee considered the draft report at its meeting of 18 March 1986. At that meeting it adopted the proposal for a decision as a whole by 12 votes to 0 with 1 abstention.

The report was tabled on 21 March 1986.

The deadline for tabling amendments to this report will be indicated in the draft agenda for the part-session at which it will be debated.

The Committee on Budgetary Control hereby submits to the European Parliament the following proposal for a decision:

PROPOSAL FOR A DECISION

postponing the discharge in respect of the 1984 financial year - Section I - European Parliament

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 85 of the Financial Regulation (OJ No. L 356 of 31.12.1977),
- having regard to its Rules of Procedure, and in particular Rule 115(3),
- having regard to Article 15 of the Internal Rules (PE 83.848/BUR/Ann.),
- at the request of its Committee on Budgetary Control (Doc. A 2-13/86),
- whereas, owing to unresolved accounting problems concerning the balance sheets for earlier years, the Committee on Budgetary Control has not yet concluded its work in this area and is therefore unable to submit to Parliament the report on the discharge in respect of Parliament's accounts for the 1984 financial year within the time limit laid down by the Financial Regulation,

1. Postpones its decision on the discharge to be granted to the Parliament authorities responsible in respect of the 1984 financial year.
