EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Subject : Draft Council Regulation amending Regulations (EEC) No 2727/75 on the Common organisation of the market in cereals, No 3330/74, on the common organisation of the market in sugar, and No 950/68 on the Common Customs Tariff

1. The purpose of this proposal is :

- a) to transfer maltodextrines (present CCT heading No 17.02 D II) caramelised sugars (present CCT heading No 17.02 F) and flavoured maltodextrine syrup (present CCT heading No 21.07 F IV) from the market organisation for sugar to that for cereals, and
- b) to extend the possibility of granting production refunds to maize "grutten" (large maize groats) used for brewing.

2. Maltodextrine, caramelised sugars and flavoured and maltodextrine syrups are, at present, subject to the sugar regime despite their being largely derived, particularly in the Community, from maize. It would, therefore, be appropriate in future for these products to be subject to the cereals regime. One of the effects of making this transfer will be that in any export refund which may be granted for any of these products being derived from the raw material normally used in its manufacture (ie maize).

3. Maize "grutten" are a larger version of the more usual maize groats, which are widely used throughout the Community for brewing and which qualify for production refunds. The additional notes to the CCT lay down a maximum size of 2 mm for maize groats. Brewers in certain Member States, however, are obliged for technical reasons to use maize flakes derived from a product (grutten) which is fundamentally the same as maize groats but which exceeds the maximum size provided for in the CCT notes. As a result, this larger product (grutten) cannot be considered as a maize groat and does not, therefore, qualify for a production refund. It also falls under a different tariff heading; 11.02 B II c as opposed to 11.02 A V a) 1. The function of the maize in the brewing process is identical whether the groat is over or under 2 mm in size and the brewery's choice between the two depends entirely on its equipment. It is for this reason that it is proposed to extend the possibility of paying production refunds to maize grutten used for brewing.

4. The changes described in paragraph 2 involve alterations to the Common Customs Tariff. The extension of production refunds to grutten necessitates a change in the import levy arrangements for this product which requires a change in the Common Customs Tariff.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (1),

Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee (2),

Whereas experience has shown that in the Community maltodextrine, maltodextrine syrups and caramelised sugars tend to be derived from cereals; whereas, therefore, it is appropriate that these products should be to the common organisation of the market in cereals;

Whereas, pursuant to Article 11(1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75(3), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) 1870/80(4), a production refund may be granted in respect of maize used for the manufacture of maize groats and meal used in brewing; whereas maize "grutten", which compete for the same outlet are not entitled to the same refund; whereas it is appropriate to introduce the possibility of granting a production refund in respect of maize employed for the manufacture of "grutten" used in brewing;

Whereas these changes necessitate amendments to Council Regulations (EEC) No 3330/74(5), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2538/80(8);

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 is hereby amended as follows :

1. Article 11 (1) is hereby replaced by the following text :

"1. A production refund may be granted :

(a) for maize and common wheat used in the Community for the manufacture of starch;

- (b) for potato starch produced in the Community;
- (c) for maize groats and meal used in the Community for the manufacture of glucose by direct hydrolysis;
- (d) for maize used in the Community for the manufacture of maize groats and meal (gritz) falling under Tariff subheading No 11.02 A V a) 1 used by the brewing industry;
- (e) for maize used in the Community for the manufacture of maize "grutten" falling under Tariff subheading No 11.02 B II c) used by the brewing industry;
- (f) for maize and common wheat used in the Community for the manufacture of quellmehl intended for bread-making.

The production refunds for the products referred to in (d) and (f) may be granted with effect from 19 October 1977."

2. Annex A is replaced by Annex I to this Regulation.

Article 2

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Subject : Draft Council Regulations amending

- a) regulation (EEC) No 2742/75 on production refunds in the cereals and rice sectors;
- b) regulation (EEC) No 2744/75 on the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice.

1. The purpose of these proposals is, in the case of a)

- to fix the same rate of production refund on maize used for making "grutten" used in brewing as that available on maize used for making groats used for the same purpose

and in the case of b)

- to make the necessary changes to the method of calculating the the import levy on maize "grutten" so as to take into account the granting of the production refund mentioned at a) above
- to extend to caramelised sugars, maltodextrine and maltodextrine syrups the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice following their incorporation in the market organisation for cereals.

2. The justifications for taking these measures are described in the explanation memorandum relating to the proposed amendment of Regulations(EEC) No 2727/75, No 3330/74 and No 950/68.

3. The measures provided for in the two attached proposals depend on the adoption by the Council of the proposed amendments referred to in paragraph 2 above.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No /80 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 11 (4) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas in view of the possibility of substitution in the production of beer between maize groats and meal on the one hand and maize "grutten" on the other, the level of the production refund to be granted on maize used for the manufacture of "grutten" for use in the production of beer, should be such as to achieve a balance between the cost of supplying the brewing industry with either maize groats and meal or maize grutten; whereas this objective would be achieved by fixing the production refund on maize for the manufacture of grutten at the same level as that on maize for the manufacture of groats and meal;

Whereas it is therefore necessary to amend Council Regulation (EEC) No 2742/75 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No (4),

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 2742/75 is hereby amended as follows :

1. The following paragraph 4 is added to Article 4:

"4. Member States shall grant a production refund of 17.23 Ecu per tonne of maize used for the manufacture of grutten falling under Tariff subheading No 11.02 B II c), used by the brewing industry in the production of beer."

2. Article 5 is hereby replaced by the following:

"Article 5

Member States shall take all necessary measures to ensure that the refunds referred to in Article 4 relating to maize groats and meal, to broken rice and to maize grutten and in Article 1 relating to quellmehl shall be limited to the quantities of maize groats and meal, broken rice, maize grutten and quellmehl actually used in the Community, as the case may be, by the brewing industry for the production of beer, for the production of glucose, or for bread making."

whereas account should be taken of the production refund in calculating the

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No ⁵⁾ amending Regulation (EEC) No
2727/75 provides for the transfer of certain processed products to the
common organization of the market for cereals; whereas provision should
be made to extend to these products the application of the system of levies
and refunds applicable in trade with third countries in products processed
from cereals and from rice,
