

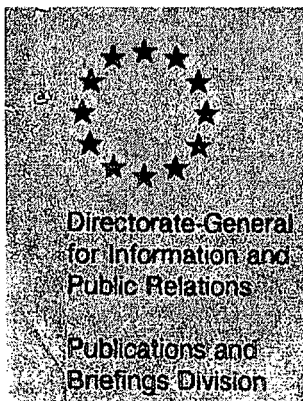

The Communist Party loss of just five seats on its 1984 performance was less than expected in view of its showing in the 1987 general election. Support for the Greens and regional parties increased at the expense of the centre parties. Italians voted 88.1% in favour and 11.9% against for an increase in the European Parliament's powers and European political union in a referendum that was conducted at the same time as the elections.

Maurice Duverger, the French politician standing on the Communist Party list was elected but former UK Liberal Party leader David Steel, who polled 15,511 votes, on the Centre Party list was not.
