FLASHBACK

The Foreign Ministers took further steps towards introducing a Community fishing limit of 200 miles by agreeing a declaration of intent which is to be ratified in September after the session of the Law of the Sea conference. This conference begins on August 2 in New York and the Member States have agreed consultation procedures so that a Community position can be adopted on as many issues as possible in this conference.

The Foreign Ministers confirmed that they would have a package of measures in September for developing the Association Agreement with Turkey and emphasized that the EEC-Turkey Association Council report should not hold up the opening negotiations with Greece which are expected to begin on July 27 in Brussels.

Various measures were agreed by the Agricultural Ministers to help deal with the draught in the Community.

No decisions were taken on the Commission's latest proposals for dealing with over-production of milk.

The European Investment Bank announced further loans of £23.1 million for developments in the U.K.
