**WILHELM HAFERKAMP, COMMON MARKET VICE-PRESIDENT, TO VISIT WASHINGTON, ALASKA**

WASHINGTON, D.C., June 1 -- Mr. Wilhelm Haferkamp, a Vice-President of the European Community (EC) Commission, arrives in Washington on Saturday, June 3, for five days of talks on energy and other questions with US Government officials.

The visit is a sequel to talks in Brussels, April 26-30, between Common Market leaders and two top State Department officials, Under Secretary John Irwin II and Deputy Under Secretary for Economic Affairs Nathaniel Samuels.

In Washington, the Commissioner is scheduled to meet Mr. Irwin, General G.A. Lincoln, Director of the Office of Emergency Preparedness, Mr. Philip J. Farley, Deputy Director of the US Arms Control and Disarmament Agency, Dr. Edward E. David, Science Adviser to the President, Dr. James E. Akins, Director of the Office of Fuels and Energy at the Department of State, Mr. Hollis M. Dole, Assistant Secretary for Mineral Resources at the Department of the Interior, and senior State Department officials concerned with European and Mid-East affairs.

Mr. Haferkamp will also spend a day at the Atomic Energy Commission headquarters in Germantown, Md.

On June 8, he will fly to Alaska for a two-day visit to oil and natural gas developments in the Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Prudhoe Bay areas.
