SCHEDULE OF EUROPEAN COMMUNITY EVENTS, NOVEMBER 1973

(ALL EVENTS ARE IN BRUSSELS UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED)

- November 5 Council of Ministers meets to discuss cooperation on development aid.
- November 6 Council of Ministers meets to discuss: improvement of Council decision-making procedures; improvement of Council relations with the EC staff; the Community position in negotiations for an arrangement concerning fibers; the status of trade negotiations with Brazil; the Commission's communication on problems from cooperation agreements' the gradual standardization of liberalization measures regarding state-trading countries; and the application of generalized preferences to developing countries in 1974.
- November 9 Council of Ministers meets to examine results of the Community's anti-inflation program; the Commission's annual report on the economic situation of the Community; its reports on short-term monetary support arrangements and conditions for pooling resources, and on the transition to the second stage of economic and monetary union.
- November 12-16 European Parliament meets in Strasbourg, France.

November 19-20

Council of Ministers meets to discuss olive oil prices, mountain agriculture, and the Commission's memorandum on the improvement of the common agricultural policy.

November 22-23

Council of Ministers meets to consider the Commission's communication on the common transport policy, the Community quota for transport authorization; weight and dimensions of vehicles; and revision of the rates system.

November 26-27

Council of Ministers meets to consider the Commission's communication on guidelines and priorities for a common energy policy.

November 26

Council of Ministers meets on the Community's association with Cyprus.

November 27

Council of Ministers meets to discuss industry and technology.
