Subject: Death sentences on three members of the ANC

In view of the constantly growing number of death sentences passed on militant political and trade union figures in South Africa (the most recent being those passed on Thelli MOGOERANE, Jeriy MOSOLOLI and Marcus MOTAUNG, members of the ANC, an organization which has been outlawed in South Africa although it has observer status at the UN) set against a background of the constant violation of human rights by the racist regime in Pretoria, what action does the Commission intend to take to contribute to the international effort aimed at putting an end to the system of apartheid in South Africa and ensuring respect for human rights and, in particular, what action does the Commission intend to take to implement the resolution adopted by the EEC/ACP Joint Committee in Salisbury?
