ANNUAL REPORT FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME FOR RESTRUCTURING THE SYSTEM OF AGRICULTURAL SURVEYS IN GREECE

1995

(Article 5, Council Decision 85/360/EEC of 16 July 1985)



J. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The plan for restructuring agricultural statistics in Greece was adopted in 1985 (Council Decision 85/360/EEC of 16 July 1985, as last amended by Council Decision 92/582/EEC of 14 December 1992 see Annex 1) with the following aims:
 - to set up a technical and administrative structure at central, regional and provincial level, capable of running all operations connected with agricultural statistics in both the present and the future;
 - the improve the sampling frames, above all by compiling a register of farm holdings;
 - to install at central, regional and sub-regional level a computer system to input, check and process data;
 - to put into practice, on a progressive basis, the Community programme of agricultural surveys and statistics in order to provide the Community with the information it requires for implementing the CAP.
- 2. As laid down in Article 5 of Council Decision 85/360/EEC, the Commission submits to the Council an annual progress report on the programme, setting out all the applications put into practice, the action taken and the measures adopted during 1995 by the competent authorities (Statistical Office and Ministry of Agriculture) in order to complete the programme.

II. PROGRESS MADE

- 1. 1995, the last year in which the programme was applied, saw the new system established throughout Greece by the agreed deadline (see Annex 1).
- 2. Some of the delays experienced in 1994 were made up in 1995.
- 3. All surveys in 1995 were designed on the basis of the new farm register, taking the agricultural holding as the sampling unit.
- 4. The farm register was updated with the help of data from all the surveys, but this affected only about 10 % of the register.
 - Since it was not possible to use administrative sources for updating purposes, it was decided to conduct a special survey or micro-census in 1996.
- 5. A pilot survey was carried out to this end in 1995 in nine municipalities in the Larisa area. The results enabled us to draw up the timetable for the special updating survey to be conducted in 1996.
- 6. The 1995 programme of statistical applications included the following surveys:

ESYE

- farm structure survey;
- survey of fruit trees (apple, pear, peach, apricot, cherry, lemon, orange, small citrus fruit);
- wine-growing survey;
- livestock survey (cattle, pigs, goats, sheep);
- cereals survey;
- slaughtering survey;
- survey of other crop products and
- the annual agricultural statistics survey.

MINAG

- estimates by geographical sampling;
- milk and milk products;
- crop production;
- production and sales of eggs by incubation (monthly survey);
- structure and use of hatcheries (annual survey);
- FADN:
- animal production: slaughterings and forecasts (meat monthly survey).

In conclusion, much progress was made during 1995. Next year, however, those responsible must also concentrate on developing databanks and drawing up a general plan for interconnection and communications between the computer systems of the Ministry of Agriculture and ESYE.

ANNEX 1

TIMETABLE REMINDER

The plan was initially to have been completed in five years (1986-1990), with geographical dissemination starting in Thrace-Macedonia in 1986 and finishing on the Island of Crete in 1990. Following two extensions granted to Greece by Council Decisions 90/386/EEC and 92/582/EEC, however, the deadline for completing the plan was put back to 1996. The new timetable is as follows:
