Subject: Rail tariffs and the port of Trieste

Having regard to the crisis currently affecting the port of Trieste and the importance that the Community should attach to its revival;

whereas this crisis is aggravated by the existing discriminatory situation brought about by the preferential tariffs applied to transport by rail to the Hanseatic ports and whereas this situation is helping to weaken Trieste's role as a central European port;

whereas the Treaty of Rome makes provision for such preferential tariffs and the Commission has repeatedly declared that they do not violate the Community rules on competition insofar as the prices are based on competition between modes of transport with particular respect to the transportation of large containers in block trains;

whereas there is no historical or geographical reason why the port of Trieste should not be granted the same rights as the Hanseatic ports;

Does not the Council consider that a protocol should be negotiated to put an end to this abnormal situation?
