pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the need for an immediate decision on financial  
support for projects to exploit alternative energy  
sources and for demonstration projects in the field  
of energy saving

'The European Parliament,

- A having regard to the vital importance of the Community's 1990 Energy Objectives to reduce the role of oil in energy consumption and to intensify exploitation of alternative energy sources and to develop the rational use of energy,
  - B having regard to the need to support demonstration projects in order to attain these objectives in the interest of the Community and all the Member States,
  - C having regard to Regulations 1302/78 and 1303/78 and to amending Regulations 725/79 and 726/79 concerning financial support to exploit alternative energy sources and financial support for demonstration projects in the field of energy saving,
  - D noting the success of Community projects for demonstrating energy savings and in the development of alternative energy sources,
  - E noting the forthcoming meeting of the Council of Ministers on 13 July 1982,
  - F having regard to Parliament's resolution of 23 April 1982,
1. Criticizes the attitude of the Council as regards the need to use appropriations for lines 703 and 704 for the attainment of these projects;
  2. Requests the Council to take the decisions which the Commission regards as necessary to enable it to implement urgently projects to exploit alternative energy sources and demonstration projects in the field of energy savings and to do so without the inclusion of any ceilings on expenditure, in accordance with the Joint Declaration of 30 June 1982;
  3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission.'
