Subject: State of relations between the Community and the United States of America

In the context of the regular inter-parliamentary meetings with the United States Congress, all aspects of the Community's relations with that country were recently examined, with particular reference to international trade, monetary affairs, energy and foreign policy.

The authors of this question, who were members of the European Parliament Delegation, returned from the United States with the feeling that the dialogue with that country on such varied and complex matters, which are of supreme importance to our Member States, should be stepped up.

1. What are the most important issues currently arising in relations between the European Community and the United States, either bilaterally or in the international context?
2. Does the Council share this feeling and what specific measures is it prepared to take in the near future to strengthen the Community's ability to speak to the United States with a single voice?
