### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The arrangements at present applicable to the vessels of non-member countries fishing in the 200-nautical-mile zone off the coast of the Department of French Guyana are laid down by Council Regulation (EEC) N° 848/81 of 27 March 1981 (1).

Since that Regulation was adopted, the Commission has received applications for licences for fishing for species other than shrimps from countries not covered in this respect in the Regulation. The Commission feels that the applications in question should be accepted, for reasons of parity of treatment of the non-member countries concerned.

The Council is consequently requested to adopt the Regulation, the proposal for which is annexed hereto.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and  
in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament (1),

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 848/81 (1), which at present governs  
fishing by vessels of non-member countries in the fishery zone of the Department  
of French Guyana, grants certain rights to particular non-member countries to  
fish for species other than shrimps;

Whereas the list of such non-member countries should be extended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The table in Point 3 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 848/81 is hereby replaced  
by the following:
