Subject: Peace and security in Europe and worldwide

Do the Foreign Ministers not feel that the present climate
of international tension constitutes a serious threat to
peace and security in Europe and worldwide?

What steps do they intend to take to help ensure the resump-
tion of the dialogue between the USA and the USSR and
international détente?

What bilateral and multilateral initiatives do they intend
to take to ensure that the Geneva talks on theatre forces
reach a positive conclusion?

Do they not feel it necessary, in this connection, to
postpone the siting of Euromissiles so as to allow time
for the negotiations to continue and thus create the
conditions needed for their successful conclusion?

Do they not feel that the massive peace demonstrations
which have taken place throughout Europe in the past few weeks
demonstrate the people of Europe's growing sense of alarm
over the arms race and do they not believe that the desire
for peace thereby given expression should receive due
consideration?
