with request that it be dealt with by urgent procedure pursuant to Rule 14 of the
Rules of Procedure

on the visit by the President of the United States of America to Europe

The European Parliament,

- in the spirit of the declaration of the Paris Summit Conference of October 1972 on the need for a reorganization of relations between Europe, and in particular the European Community on the one hand, and the United States of America on the other;
 - having regard to the statement made by Dr Kissinger, Mr Nixon's special adviser, with the President's authorization;
 - convinced of the need to adapt relations between the European Community and the United States of America to past developments and future prospects;
 - believing that the reorganization of these relations in a spirit of true partnership requires that agreed solutions be found which take due account of the worldwide responsibilities of the European Community;
1. Calls upon the Institutions of the Community and the Governments of the Member States to conduct the dialogue with the President of the United States of America during his visit in the autumn through the Council of the European Communities, meeting at the highest political level, and with the participation of the Commission of the European Communities;
 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission of the European Communities and to the Governments of the Member States.
