MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr BORD, on behalf of
the Group of European Progressive Democrats,

with request for urgent debate
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure,

on the situation in Poland and in Afghanistan

The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to the extremely tense situation prevailing in a certain area of the world,
 - B. concerned at the attitude of a section of public opinion after the tragic events in Beirut,
 - C. whereas the existence and permanence of our basic principles are dependent on the safeguarding of the security and freedom of certain third countries,
 - D. whereas the action of the European Parliament must be guided by a constant desire to seek peaceful solutions whenever possible,
1. Reaffirms the principle of the freedom of peoples to determine their own destiny;
 2. Welcomes the sending of a delegation from the European Parliament to Israel and Lebanon;
 3. Calls on the European Parliament to continue its activity by setting up an ad-hoc delegation and by arranging for it to travel initially to Poland and then to Afghanistan;
 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission.
