on the unjustified detention of Vanni Mulinaris

## The European Parliament,

)

- A. whereas Vanni MULINARIS, accused of being the mastermind of a subversive organization, has been detained in Italy since 2 February 1982 several hundred miles away from his judges, his legal representatives and his family,
- B. whereas the preparatory inquiry has not been opened, whereas a file containing specific charges has not been compiled and whereas other detainees are in the same situation,
- C. concerned that the special anti-terrorist laws under which he is detained rule out the possibility of conditional discharge unless the case is dropped and may well extend the period of his detention by several years,
- Calls on the Italian authorities to speed up the preparatory inquiry and for a trial to be held as soon as possible, if there are grounds for such a trial;
- 2. Calls on the Italian authorities to take action as quickly as possible to ensure that all the facts of this case are brought to light;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation and to the Government of the Italian Republic.
