MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr ISRAEL on behalf of the Group
of European Progressive Democrats

with request for urgent debate
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on terrorism

The European Parliament,

- A deeply moved by the persistent terrorism in Europe, particularly a number of outrages in France and notably the abominable shooting in the rue des Rosiers,
- B aware of the need to eradicate terrorism, the veritable cancer of Western society,
- C aware that there can never be any justification for terrorist acts,
- D aware that peace in the world, and in particular in the Middle East, can only be established on solid foundations if terrorism in all its forms is banned, repressed and finally conquered,
1. Asks the Council to do everything possible to ensure that any proposal for a settlement of the crisis in the near East contains an explicit reference to the need to renounce terrorism;
 2. Asks the Council to continue and step up cooperation as regards the combating of the political, racist or criminal terrorism which is rampant in Europe;
 3. Urgently requests that any concession towards terrorists, for any reason, should be expressly condemned;
 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and to the Ministers of Foreign Affairs meeting in Political Cooperation.
