MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr LAGAKOS

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the setting up of a standing joint

EEC-COMECON Committee

The European Parliament,

- whereas the EEC and COMECON are the two principal political and economic organizations which represent the overwhelming majority of European States,
- whereas in the present political situation a dialogue and peaceful cooperation between these two political and economic organizations is more necessary than ever,
- whereas the intractable social and economic problems facing Europe and indeed the whole world can only be solved through a rapprochement between the two parties,
- whereas any attempt at rapprochement and dialogue is of vital interest for détente and peace,

Proposes:

1. the creation of a standing Joint EEC-COMECON Committee at the level of experts of the States represented to ensure better mutual understanding and provision of information and correct identification of the points of convergence and also of the differences between the two organizations,
2. instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission and the Governments of the Member States.
