MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr COTTRELL

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on a time limit for competent authorities within Member States to respond to questions raised by the European Parliament's Committee on the Rules of Procedure and Petitions

### The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to Article 179 of the Treaty of Rome
- B. observing the lengthening delays in responses being received by the Committee on the Rules of Procedure and Petitions to questions asked by that committee through the Commission as a result of petitions being judged admissible
- C. noting that this seriously hampers the work of the committee and represents a disservice to petitioners
- D. considering that the Commission and its services have done everything possible to encourage a swift response to queries raised with the competent authorities in Member States
- E. nevertheless observing that some Member States appear to adopt, at worst, a policy of non-co-operation and at best, the slowest possible responsible

#### **RESOLVES**

- 1. That appropriate measures be taken to impose a time limit for the Committee on the Rules of Procedure and Petitions to receive a response from Member States with regard to the substance of admissible petitions
- 2. That in breach of such a time limit a period of two months may reasonably be imposed the European Court be asked to make a legal proposal within the framework of Article 179 of the Treaty
