MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr COTTRELL and Mr FORTH

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on an enforcement of the European Court's rulings

### The European Parliament,

- A. noting with increasing concern the reluctance of Member States to obey rulings of the Court of Justice,
- B. noting in this respect the continuing lack of compliance by Italy with a number of judgements of the Court, some of which are of considerable antiquity,
- C. recalling the refusal of the French Government to comply promptly with a ruling of the Court concerning sheepmeat, due to the pressure applied by the agricultural lobby,
- D. noting that the United Kingdom is now in breach of a ruling of the Court concerning poultry and poultry desease regulations,
- E. observing that the Community will fail in all its objectives unless Member States are willing to grant the Court of Justice respect and compliance,
- F. questions whether the Governments of the Member States would encourage their own national citizens to disregard the judgements and rulings of national courts,

### RESOLVES

- 1. To request the Council of Ministers to restore credibility to the Court of Justice as an instrument for resolving disputes between the Member States by requesting immediate compliance with its judgements;
- 2. To seek a meeting between the principal institutions of the Community Parliament, Commission, Council and the Court of Justice - to consider the most effective means by which enforcement of the Court's rulings can be applied.
