MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION tabled by Mr KYRKOS pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure on the establishment of the common organization of the market in the saffron sector

## The European Parliament,

A. whereas Greece is the only country in the Community where saffron is produced,

- B. whereas saffron production provides employment for 2,500 families who earn 70% of their income from producing saffron,
- C. whereas the crocus is grown in dry and infertile areas unsuitable for other kinds of cultivation,
- D. whereas saffron production in the Community has recently been subjected to strong external pressures from countries with low labour costs making it difficult to find an outlet for the product,
- E. whereas the bulk of the Greek output of saffron, which amounts to 11 tonnes, is consumed by the Community,
- F. whereas the income of producers has been falling in recent years as a result of strong competition from countries with low labour costs,
- G. whereas, for reasons of justice and fair treatment of farmers in the Community, saffron producers should not be excluded from the protection of the common organization of the market,
- 1. Calls on the Commission:
  - (a) to take immediate measures to ensure that Community preference is given to providing an outlet for saffron produced by Community undertakings,
  - (b) to take an immediate decision to provide financial aid for saffron producers for the current growing season,
  - (c) to cooperate with the Greek Government with a view to establishing a common organization of the market in the saffron sector,
  - (d) to recognize the Saffron Producers Association as a saffron producer group and give it the financial benefits provided for producer groups;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council of Ministers and the Governments of the Member States.
