with request for urgent debate

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the EEC-YUGOSLAVIA COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to the serious crisis in Yugoslavia, as shown by the devaluation of the currency and by other recent austerity measures implemented with respect to the country's economy,
  - B. having regard to the delay in implementing the cooperation agreement between the Community and Yugoslavia as a result of the delays in ratifying it,
  - C. recalling again with bitterness the interpretations given by the Council to the implementation of the trade agreements following Greece's accession to the Community,
  - D. noting that the crisis affecting the Yugoslavian economy and the restrictive provisions are having direct effects on the economy of the regions of the Community bordering on Yugoslavia, such as Friuli-Venezia Giulia,
1. Reconfirms the primary political interest of the European Community in an economically sound and politically independent Yugoslavia capable of playing its role for peace in the world.
  2. Urges a rapid conclusion of the ratification process.
  3. Calls on the Community's responsible bodies to implement swiftly the projects planned so far.
  4. Appreciates the determination of the Yugoslavian Government to give a vigorous boost to the country's economy and its desire to remain faithful to its international commitments.
  5. Calls on the Commission to consider the possibility of reviewing the contents of the agreement, particularly as regards the tariff arrangements applied to 'baby beef'.
  6. Instructs the Committee on External Economic Relations and the Political Affairs Committee to present to it a report on relations between the Community and Yugoslavia.
  7. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission.
