with request for topical and urgent debate

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the plight of Kenyan-Asians who hold British passports

'The European Parliament,

- A aware of the fact that 17,000 Asians resident in Kenya are British passport holders,
- B noting that during the attempted 'coup d'etat' in August this year £400 million worth of damage was caused to property,
- C realizing that 90% of the property damaged belonged to people of Asian origin,
- D understanding that the state-owned insurance companies refuse to make payment for the damage, as they will not accept that an attempted 'coup d'etat' took place,
- 1. Requests the British government to make representations to the Kenyan government on behalf of the holders of British passports who are making claims on insurance companies;
- 2. Urges the Kenyan government to instruct their state-owned insurance companies to honor their obligations and settle claims for damage incurred at the time of the attempted 'coup d'etat';
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the governments of the United Kingdom and Kenya;
