on the extradition of Klaus Barbie

The European Parliament,

- whereas Klaus Barbie conducted the most deadly operation against the French Resistance in Lyons from 1943 to 1944, had Jean Moulin arrested, interrogated and tortured so that he died as a result;
  - whereas he was sentenced to death in absentia on 16 May 1947 and again on 28 November 1954 by the Lyons military tribunal;
  - whereas since 12 February 1982 the Public Prosecutor of Lyons has instituted fresh legal proceedings against him for crimes against humanity;
  - whereas Klaus Barbie is at present living in Bolivia;
  - whereas the French and German Governments have appealed to the Bolivian Government to extradite him;
1. Calls on the Bolivian Government to grant this extradition request;
  2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the French, German and Bolivian Governments.
