MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr KIRK

on behalf of the European Democratic Group

pursuant to Rule 106 of the Rules of Procedure

on the setting up of a parliamentary delegation to GATT

The European Parliament,

- A - Referring to its decision on the establishment of interparliamentary delegations of 22 April 1982,
- B - Referring to the Ministerial Meeting in GATT on 22 - 29 November 1982,
- C - Referring to Articles 137, 155 and 116 of the EEC Treaty,
- D - Considering that negotiations within GATT can be of the utmost importance to the future of the European Communities, and world economy as a whole,
 - 1. Decides to add to the number of delegations a parliamentary delegation to GATT;
 - 2. Instructs its President to establish contact with the Commission to determine the practical details for participation by the Delegation in future GATT meetings as part of the Commission's delegation, so that a draft decision can be presented to Parliament on the number of Members and the powers of the Delegation pursuant to Rule 106, paras. 2 and 4 of the Rules of Procedure at the February part-session.
