with request for topical and urgent debate  
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the situation in Poland

## The European Parliament

- A. concerned at developments in Poland and the continued disregard for human rights shown by Jaruzelski's dictatorial regime,
  - B. considering that the supposed easing of martial law which has now been in force for one year has, because of its provisional nature, its numerous exemptions and the incorporation of many provisions of martial law in ordinary legislation, failed to restore convincingly the rights of the Polish people,
  - C. conscious of the traditional ties between Poland and Europe and the duty of free and democratic peoples to intercede for the freedom and self-determination of the Polish people,
1. Calls on the Foreign Ministers of the Community meeting in political cooperation, the Council, the governments of the Member States and the Commission
    - to follow closely developments in Poland,
    - to base judgements of events in Poland on facts rather than words, promises or official statements,
    - to respond to the continued violations of fundamental and human rights by taking appropriate tangible measures,
    - to notify the rulers in Warsaw and Polish public opinion adequately of this resolution adopted by the representatives of the people of Europe;
  2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Foreign Ministers of the Community meeting in political cooperation, the Council, the governments of the Member States and the Commission.
