MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr SCHIELER

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the undiminished discharge of chlorides into the Rhine

The European Parliament,

- A - disturbed by the fact that the discharge into the Rhine of harmful chlorides, particularly by the Alsace potash mines, is continuing undiminished,
- B - having regard to the French Government's delay in taking action on its declaration of intent to reduce by 20 kilogrammes per second the discharge of chlorides into the Rhine,
- C - having regard to motions for resolutions Nos. 1-500/79, 1-523/79, 1-592/79, 1-597/79, 1-601/79, 1-120/81,
 1. Calls on the Commission, in the interests of the people of the countries on the Rhine, to request the French Government at last to act on its promise to reduce the discharge of chlorides by the Alsace potash mines;
 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council and the governments of the Member States.
