on the South Korean aircraft shot down by the Soviet
air force

The European Parliament

- A. deeply indignant at the destruction of a South Korean civil aeroplane by a Russian military aircraft,
1. Denounces the despicable character of an act which exhibits the total disregard of the Soviet authorities for internationally recognized and respected principles;
 2. Calls on the Governments of the Member States of the Community to agree upon measures to be taken against the Soviet Union;
 3. Considers that Aeroflot should be isolated in the context of international civil aviation until such time as the Soviet Union accepts full responsibility for its act;
 4. Wishes the European Community to take steps to allow an international agreement to be concluded with a view to guaranteeing safe conditions for civil aviation;
 5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation, the Council and the Commission.
