MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr PEARCE

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on Emergency Delegate's Fund for small-scale emergencies

PE 86.737

The European Parliament,

- A. conscious that the lack of relatively minor items or expenditure can sometimes delay urgent activities,
  - B. aware that the referral of all decisions back to Brussels by the Delegation in a third country can lead to a further delay in implementation,
  - C. considering that EEC delegations are often the best able to judge whether local circumstances demand slight modifications to existing activities,
1. Calls on the CEC to present proposals to give CEC delegates in Lome countries authority to have access to a small-scale "Delegates Emergency Fund". The purposes of this fund would be to give delegates discretion to allocate funds for urgent, immediate needs in the cases of small-scale emergencies;
  2. Such allocations would be available for use by the delegation, the Government of the recipient state or other organisations.
