on Ravenscraig

The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to the importance of Ravenscraig to the Scottish economy,
- B. having regard to the need for Ravenscraig's steel-making capacity in the event of an up-turn in the steel industry,
- C. having regard to the fact that Ravenscraig is now one of the most modern, efficient, steel plants in Europe,
- D. having regard to the enormous sacrifices made by the steel workers in Motherwell to support Commissioner Andriessen's strategy to achieve viability in the steel industries in the Member States,
- E. having regard to the massive job losses in Britain while Italy, for example, has increased capacity,
- Censures Commissioner Andriessen for his total failure to achieve balance in the steel industries throughout the Community;
- 2. Supports the attempts to retain the steel-making capacity of Ravenscraig;
- 3. Calls on the Commission to support the efforts of the Unions and Management to retain steel-making capacity at least at its present level at Ravenscraig.
