MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

pursuant to Rule 47 and Rule 112 of the Rules of Procedure

on the amendment of Rule 60(1) of the Rules of Procedure
of the European Parliament

The European Parliament,

- whereas the United States Senate has amended its rules of procedure, on the proposal of Senator Claiborne Pell (Democrat/Rhode Island), to allow Members of the European Parliament to be present at debates of the Senate,

- recognizing that this amendment to the rules of procedure of the United States Senate represents a particular honour for the European Parliament as an institution,

- 1. Instructs its Committee on the Rules of Procedure and Petitions to amend Rule 60 of the Rules of Procedure concerning access to the Chamber to allow - in addition to Members of Parliament - members of the Commission and the Council, Parliament's Secretary-General, staff members present on official business, Community consultants and officials, and also members of the United States Senate, access to the Chamber and to submit this amendment to the European Parliament;

- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Vice-President of the United States of America in his capacity as President of the United States Senate.
