## The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to the fact that since the military intervention of 12 September 1980, the work of the association bodies has only been maintained through contacts at ambassadorial level in the Association Council,
- B. having regard to the referendum of 7 November 1982 on the new Turkish constitution,
- C. having regard to the resolution on the political situation in Turkey adopted on 8 July 1982<sup>1</sup>,
- D. stressing its wish for the lifting of martial law and of restrictions on fundamental human rights as well as an early restoration of democracy,
- 1. Underlines the necessity to start preparations in the field of external economic relations to resume the EEC-Turkey association relations as soon as the necessary conditions are fulfilled;
- 2. Is convinced that a stable economy in Turkey is the basis for a working democracy and that the Community must contribute to such stability within the framework of the Association Agreement;
- 3. Calls on its relevant committee to draw up, on the basis of comprehensive information from the Commission, a report on the current state of affairs in the Association and the work required to revive economical Association relations;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission of the European Communities, the EEC-Turkey Association Council and the governments of the Member States and Turkey.
